Re: Common Council File No. 000982

I have reviewed the fiscal note in Common Council File No. 000982, which reports the impact of the wage agreement prepared by the Labor Negotiator for Milwaukee District Council 48, AFSCME, AFL-CIO. The total incremental costs as developed by my staff for this two year agreement by category are:

While we have reviewed all of the items, the Labor Negotiator's pension costs were developed by the actuary. We are not in a position to recompute these figures, as we do not have the appropriate database. We have found the balance of the figures in the note to be reasonable based on the data received. The figures developed by the Labor Negotiator are adequate for use in the file.
