Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with
warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. This report is written by Police Officer MONREAL, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 11/13/2019 at 3:32am officers were dispatched to a hold up alarm. The officers checked the business and found no signs of entry. The officers contacted the manager, who stated the alarm has been malfunctioning lately.

2. On 05/12/23 at 6:32p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Gambling complaint at 510 W. Vine St. On arrival officers observed several subjects standing outside of the location standing in a semi-circle with money laying on the ground. One of the subjects was arrested for gambling and drug possession charges. The agent was not on scene; however, the officers interviewed the cashier regarding the violation. The cashier was not cooperative with the police and did not understand why the officers were there because the gambling outside had nothing to do with the store. The cashier further stated to the officer they would no longer call the police for issues at the store because it will make the store look bad and they didn't want to put the license at risk by calling the police. It should be noted the officer felt the cashier was nervous during the investigation and it appeared they did not want customers to hear them speaking with the officer.

3. On 05/22/23 at 12:28p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 510 W. Vine St. This was in regard to complaints of loitering and possible drug dealing in the area. On arrival officers observed several occupied vehicles parked in front, however, a few of them did enter the store and came out with purchases. The officers spoke to the employee and advised them of the reason for the check. The employee stated they had been calling for loitering calls, however the police rarely showed up due to the priority of the call. The employee was encouraged to continue to call for police service. The employee did fill out a standing loitering complaint form and posted a provided no loitering sign.

This report was written by PO Nora BURLO, assigned to District Five Late Power shift. On Saturday May 12th, 2023, I was assigned to Squad 5468 along with my partner PO James TERRELL. On the listed date, PO TERRELL and I were dispatched to the address 510 W Vine (Penny Saver Foods) at approximately 7:09 PM, for a Gambling Complaint. The listed location is a licensed premise in the City of Milwaukee.

Prior to officer arrival, the complaint indicated there were several subjects playing dice/ gambling outside of the location.

Upon officer arrival, PO TERRELL and I observed the five (5) B/M subjects standing on the SOUTH side of the street, directly in front of the listed address. I observed several bills of US currency on the ground as the group of subjects stood around the money in a semi-circle. One B/M male subject immediately began walking away from the location upon him seeing officers. PO TERRELL attempted to make contact with the subject; however, he was unable to due to the subject continuously walking away from him. PO TERRELL then returned back to where I was standing with the male subjects. I informed the male subjects the money would blow away, I observed three of the four subjects bend down and retrieve bills, ultimately placing them in their pockets.

PO TERRELL and I then began to attempted to obtain identification for each subject however one male subject, later identified as **Maximus C WINFREY (B/M, 5/29/02)** began walking away from officers. He was ultimately detained and placed into custody. WINFREY was initially going to be issued citations for gambling and possession of THC. Once WINFREY was conveyed to District Five, a second search of his person was conducted where officers located a clear plastic baggie of powder methamphetamine. He was then issued charges regarding.

Officers identified the three other male subjects and notified them they could all receive gambling citations in the mail. They were provided contact cards prior our ending contact with them.

FOLLOW-UP:

I made contact with the cashier/ manager at Penny Saver Foods. He was not cooperative with me, initially as he questioned my asking for his identification. He later identified himself as **Shaker A ALI (W/M, 1/16/74)**. ALI repeatedly stated the gambling officers witnessed had nothing to do with Penny Saver Foods. He was upset with my presence in the store and needed me to explain my role as an officer assigned to patrol licensed premises in District Five. ALI stated he has worked at the location for approximately twenty (20) years. He works three- four day a week from wither 6:00 AM until 9:00 PM, or

his hours will vary to 9:00 AM until 6:00 PM.

As I spoke with ALI, I observed the business licensing information for the store. It was posted behind the locked employee area near the register. I observed the malt beverage license (# 0199536) and related cigarette & tobacco license (# 1031379), both will expire on 11/21/2023. I observed the food dealer retail license (# 0013419) which also expires 11/21/2023. I observed the weights & measures license (# 0007512), also expiring 11/21/2023.

I observed the store to be clean. There was a consistent number of customers who came and went through my entirety of my business check. I observed ALI to be nervous and appeared to not want customers to hear him talking with me. ALI expressed frustration with officers and informed me that the store will not call for police assistance if there are any issues at the location because it will make the store look bad. He stated he does not want the businesses license to be at risk by him calling the police.

This report is written by PO Christopher J SCHLEI, PS 022571, assigned to District 5 - early power shift.

On Monday, May 22nd 2023 at 12:28pm, myself (squad 5264) and PO COLWELL (squad 5266) responded to 510 W Vine St, in the city and county of Milwaukee, for a check of the location with the Department of Neighborhood Services. We had received several complaints regarding loitering outside of the location and possible drug dealing in the area.

On arrival there were roughly 5-6 vehicles parked on the street in front of the location. There were some individuals in their vehicles but there was no one loitering around the store. There were several subjects that did go in and out of the store a couple times from their vehicles but they left with merchandise each time.

In the store I spoke with Shaker A ALI. ALI stated he was an employee of the store and the owner was not on scene. We let ALI know what brought us to the store and ALI became very passionate in his response. ALI stated he had been calling the police but they usually never showed up due to the "priority" of the call. Loitering calls are generally entered as a Trouble with Subject which, barring any other info such as the presence of weapons, is given a priority 3 designation. I expressed to ALI that I can see his frustration with the response times. I encouraged ALI to continue to call to show that the store is trying what they can to get the issue taken care of. ALI stated that sometimes people will leave when asked and go down the road and sometimes they will give him some issues. ALI stated that a lot of the issue subjects have told him they are there for business with the hotel (1840 N 6th St). What ALI told me did make sense. ALI did fill out a standing complaint form and will put up the "no loitering" signs we provided. ALI stated the store had been quiet up until late last year when the issues started appearing in the area.

The location did have all its permits displayed and in order.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 10/17/2023 at 9:25 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
