RIGHT TURNS ON RED WHEN DISPLAYED
SOUTHBOUND ON SOUTH 20TH STREET
AT WEST MORGAN AVENUE

Dear Alderman Witkowski:

To reduce traffic delay for southbound right turning vehicles on South 20th Street at West Morgan Avenue, the current static sign prohibiting right turns on red will be replaced with an electronic sign prohibiting right turns on red when displayed. The prohibition of right turns on red provides gaps for forklifts for A-1 Recycling crossing West Morgan Avenue west of South 20th Street. However, this restriction is not necessary during hours when forklifts from A-1 Recycling are not crossing West Morgan Avenue or from 4:30 pm to 6:00 am. Therefore we recommend that an electronic sign prohibiting right turns on red when displayed be installed to replace the existing static sign prohibiting right turns on red.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting so that you may support it to final passage.
