The Health Department is submitting the following grant resolution for Common Council approval.

<u>Women, Infants and Children's Grant</u> - This continued funding from the U.S. Department of Agriculture through the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services helps to prevent nutrition-related health problems and to improve the health status of low income, at-risk pregnant or breast feeding infants and children up to the age of five years.

<u>Lead Demonstration Grant</u> - This file amends Common Council 041037 which approved the application, acceptance and funding of this grant. The grant will make an additional 1,295 housing units lead-safe with a community-based organization to assure lead-safe and habitable housing in the southside target area. Changes to the Positions Ordinance are incorporated in this file.

 $\underline{\text{MBCAP Outreach Grant}}$  - This continued funding from the Susan B. Komen Foundation will be used to provide education to women ages 40 and over on breast health, breast self-exam and breast cancer screening quidelines.

<u>Municipal Health Services Program</u> - This continuing grant from the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services waives certain Medicare reimbursement limitations for Medicare beneficiaries.
