There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/26/2018 at 1:15 PM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

This report is typed by P.O. Steven Roufus assigned to District Five Early. On Wednesday November 22, 2017, I was part of the CODE RED Deployment, P.O. Kristopher Sardina and I were assigned to N. Jefferson St.

At 1:45 AM, we were flagged down on N. Jefferson St. by a unknown citizen stating there is a fight at Flannery's at 425 E. Wells St.

Upon arrival there were people arguing and an individual later identified as Zachery C. DeBacco W/M, 10/30/1981, 2811 Lincolnshire Ct. Waukesha WI. 53186 Phone 1-262-510-6197 was bleeding from his hand saying someone threw a glass and it hit me. Mr. DeBacco refused medical. Mr. DeBacco was conveyed to St. Mary's by friends for the laceration on the top of his right hand. Mr. DeBacco said the subjects involved are right there, and pointed them out (Unknown H/M, tall, wearing a Wisconsin Badger coat and hat, standing by the table next to them outside).

P.O. Sardina and I were able to locate the subjects. One subject later identified as Manual A. Mercado, H/M, 6/13/1991 who admitted that he threw a bottle or a glass inside Flannery's Bar but had no intention of hurting anyone. Mr. Mercado said he found a hat on the floor and put it on. Mr. Mercado said someone took the hat off his head and pushed him. Mr. Mercado said his friends started to push the other subjects back. Mr. Mercado said he believed it was friends of Mr. DeBacco's. Mr. Mercado said his friends started pushing back and bar personnel came to stop the fight. Mr. Mercado said at some point he didn't know what he threw, a bottle or glass. Mr. Mercado said the bar personnel escorted people out of the bar. Mr. Mercado said he had no intention of hurting anyone. Mr. Mercado was given a Citation for Disorderly conduct.

I interviewed the bartender Alexandra L. Makal who said she observed the altercation starting and notified bar personnel. Ms. Makal didn't know who threw the glass.

All parties involved were intoxicated.

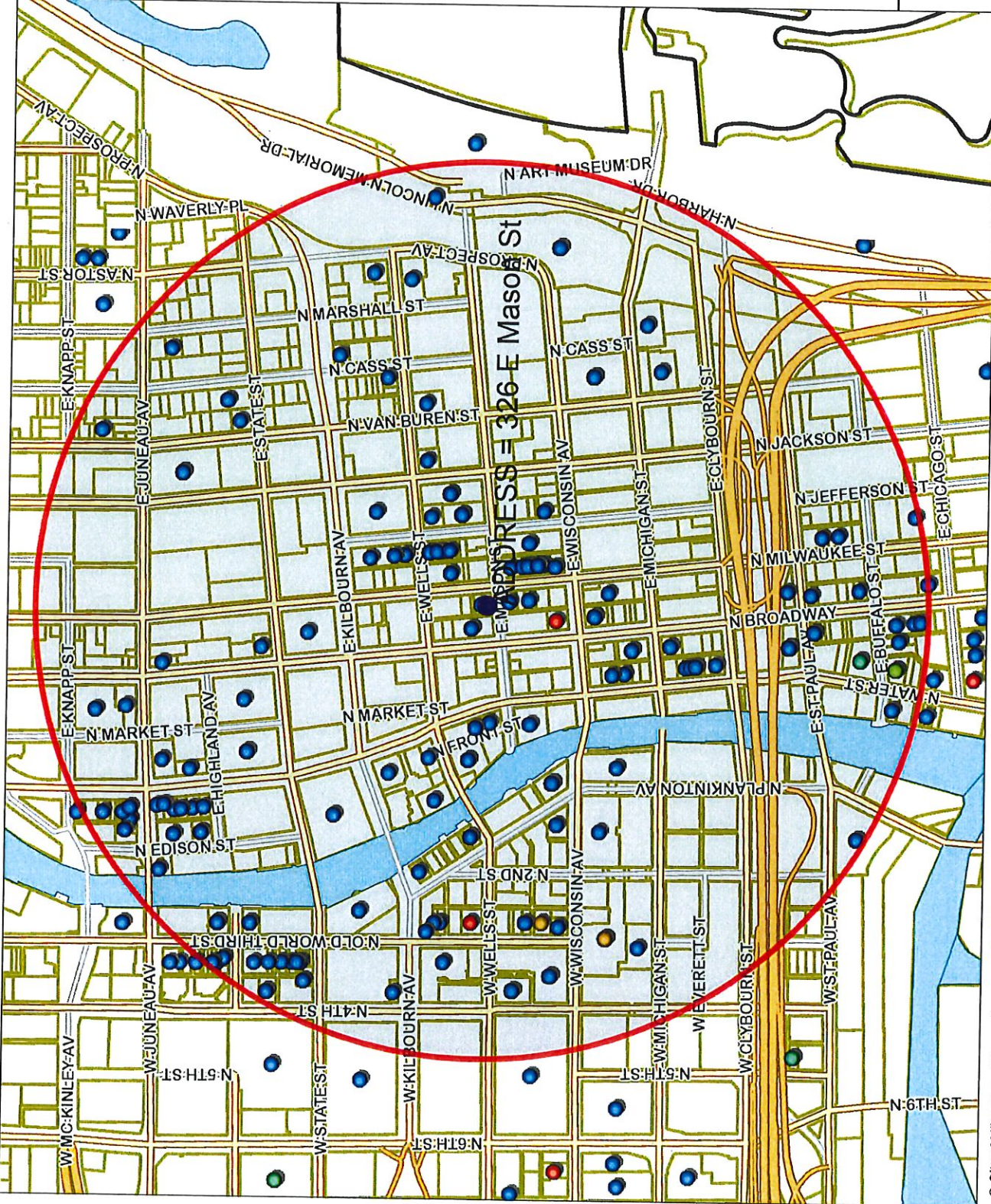

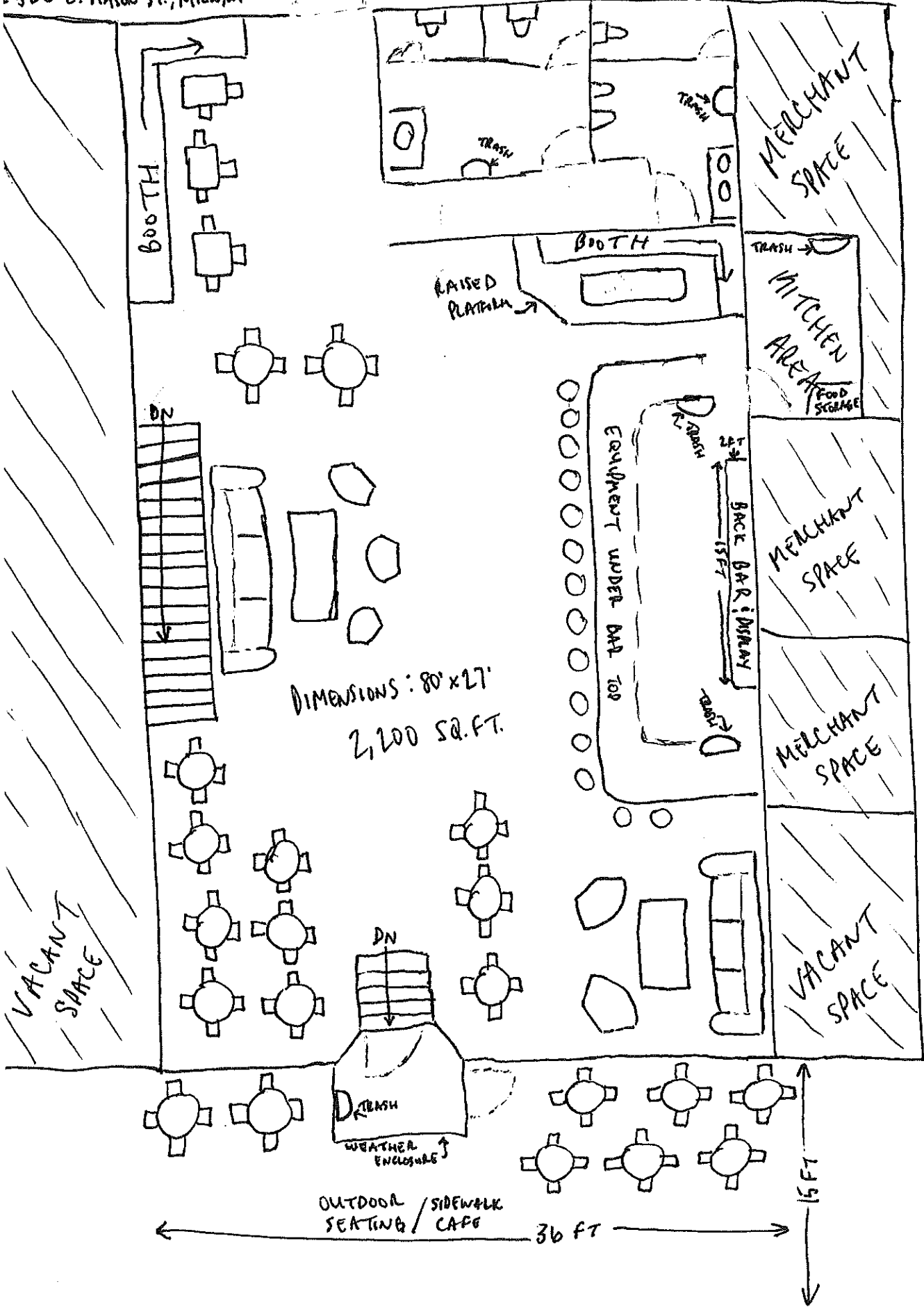

1ST FLOOR PLAN

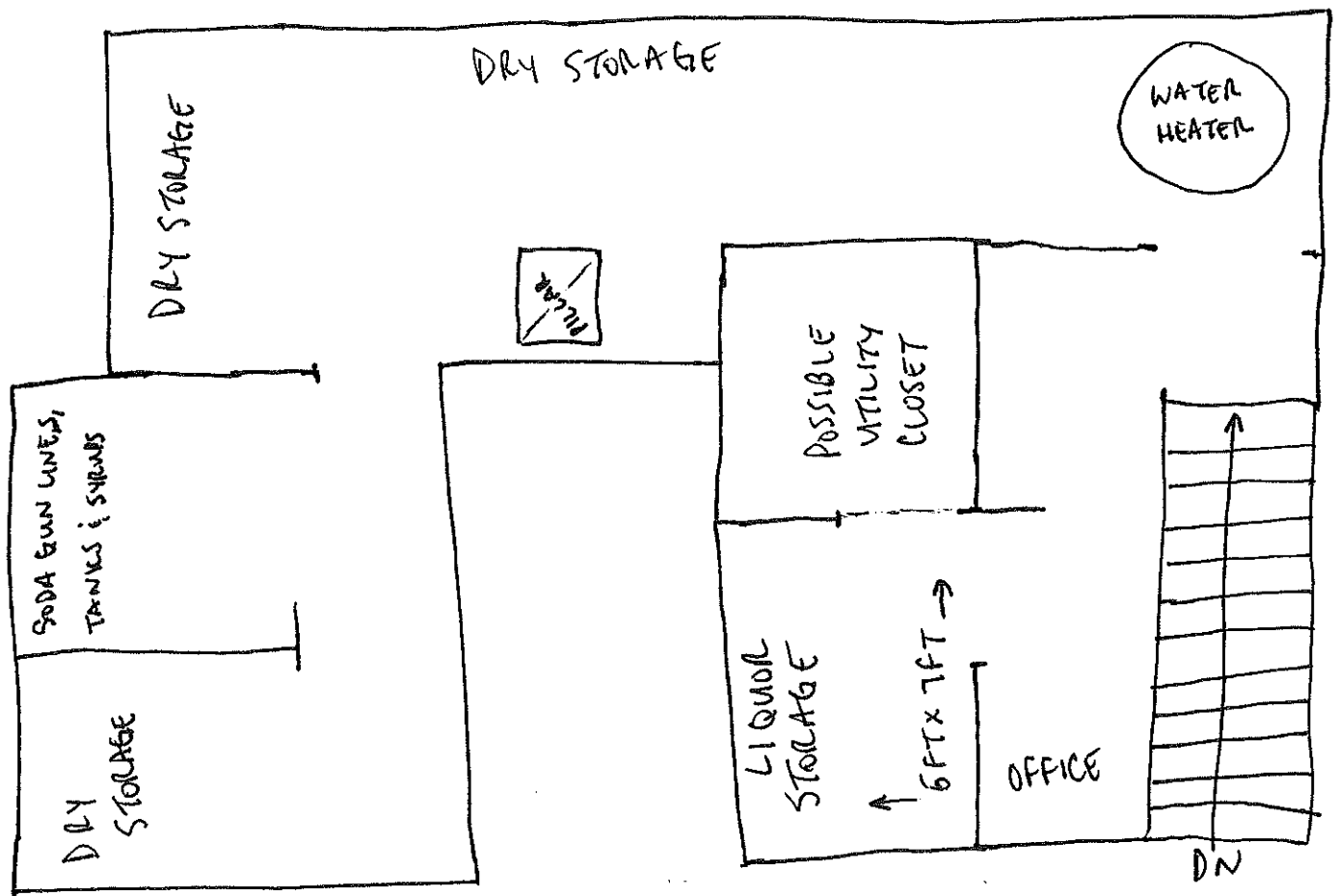
COMMON AREA HALLWAY/ADA ENTRANCE

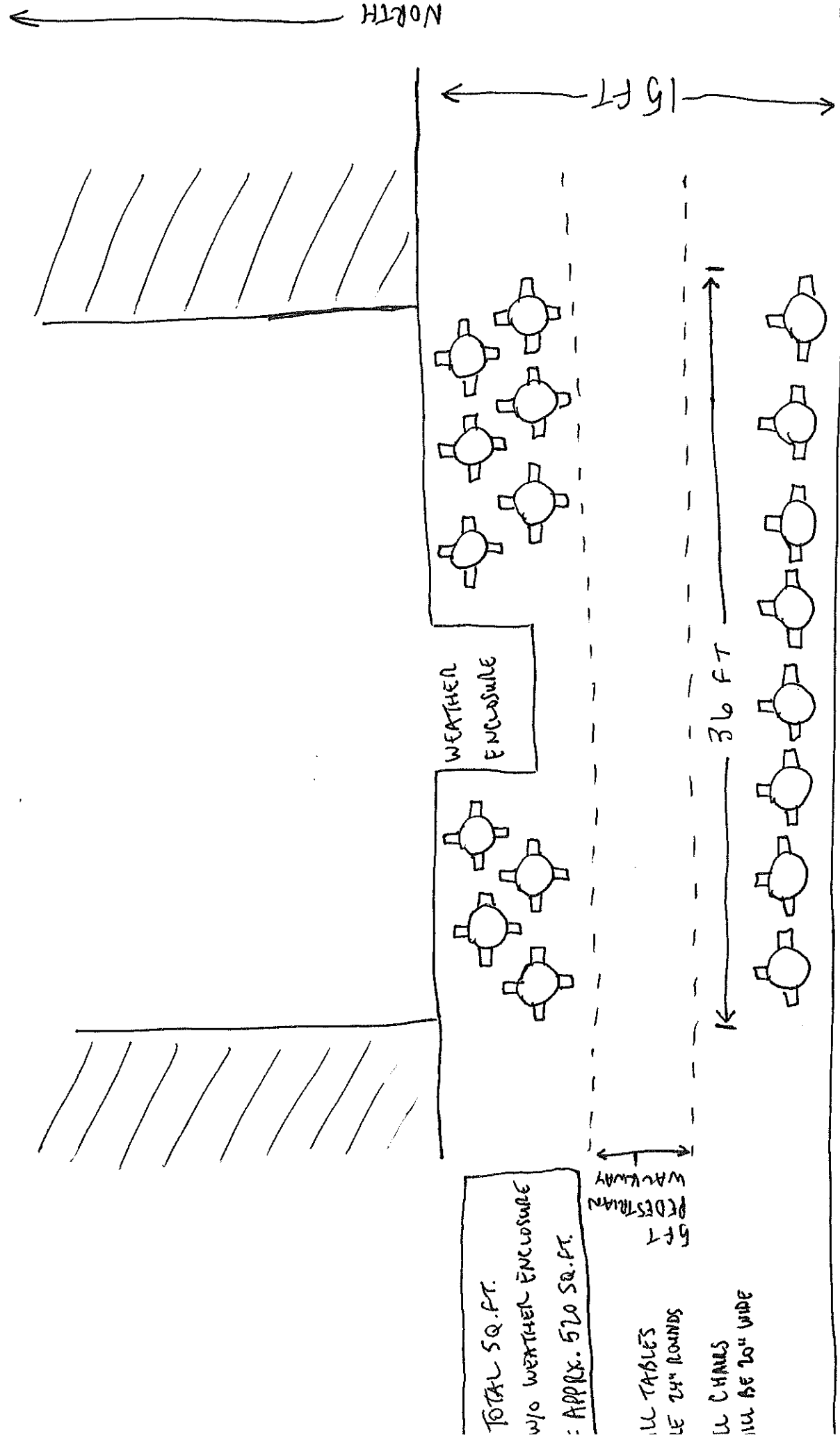
