Substitute resolution authorizing the Port of Milwaukee to accept and expend a grant from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program relating to Milwaukee River Bulkhead Survey.

..Analysis

This resolution authorizes the Port of Milwaukee to accept and expend a grant from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program relating to a Milwaukee River Bulkhead survey. The Grant is an operating Grant for \$40,000 from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program and \$60,000 from in kind City and Port staff time.

..Body

Whereas, The Port of Milwaukee has applied for and received a Grant from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program relating to a Milwaukee River Bulkhead survey.

Whereas, The information from this Milwaukee River Bulkhead Survey Project will aid a number of City Departments in updating property records and having accurate information for issuing permits.

Whereas, The operation of this grant from 6/11/2012 through 6/30/2013 would cost \$100,000 of which \$60,000 would be provided by in-kind staff time of City employees and \$40,00 would be provided by the grantor; now therefore be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Port of Milwaukee is hereby authorized to accept and execute such a Grant without further Common Council approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Section 304-81, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2013 Special Revenue – Grant and Aid Projects, the following amounts for the project titled: “Milwaukee River Bulkhead Survey”:

Further Resolved, That the Port of Milwaukee is authorized to expend the funds.
