

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Carolyn Lacy, a City of Milwaukee Detective, was in the scope of her employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee Police vehicle that was stopped northbound on West Fond du Lac Avenue at the intersection with West Roosevelt Drive. At that time, the uninsured motorist, who was also traveling northbound on West Fond du Lac Avenue, failed to stop and rear-ended the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to §62.67 Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Detective Lacy sustained injuries to her neck and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$15,163.28.
