On August 30th, 2023 at approximately 2:36pm, PO ZELINSKI and I were dispatched to 945 N 12th St.#25, (Mt. Sanai) to investigate a Sexual Assault Complaint.

On scene, I interviewed Alexis R MYERS (white female, 9/1/04) who stated she was sexual assaulted in the Walmart parking lot located at 401 E Capitol Drive on 8/30/23, at approximately 6:30am.

MYERS stated she was sleeping on a bench, in front of the Walmart located at 401 E Capitol Dr. MYERS stated an unknown black male, who is employed as a security officer at Walmart, sexually assaulted her inside of his personal vehicle. MYERS stated she is currently homeless, and that's why she was sleeping on the bench outside of Walmart.

MYERS stated the unknown suspect pulled up in a blue Honda (unknown plate) to where she was in front of the store and asked her to get into his vehicle. MYERS stated she responded with "No I don't wanna get in your car!" MYERS stated the unknown suspect then stated, "Get in my car or imma kill you and your family!". MYERS stated she was scared and feared he would harm her or her family. MYERS stated the unknown suspect exited his vehicle, and physically forced her into his vehicle. MYERS stated the unknown suspect demanded that she lay down inside of the vehicle. MYERS stated she observed and unknown number of pills inside of the vehicle on the floor.

MYERS stated the unknown suspect forced her to take a light blue "oval shaped" pill. MYERS stated shortly after she took the pill, she felt dizzy and lightheaded.

MYERS stated she attempted the exit the vehicle and the unknown suspect slammed the door so she could not exit the vehicle. MYERS stated the unknown suspect told her "to lay down and try to sleep."

MYERS stated the unknown suspect began to rub her thighs. MYERS stated she told the unknown suspect to stop, and he did NOT. MYERS stated the unknown suspect then proceeded to perform mouth to vagina intercourse. MYERS stated she continued to attempt to try and move away but was unsuccessful. MYERS stated the unknown suspect told her "he loved her" and "not to scream." MYERS stated after the intercourse, the unknown suspect left the vehicle.

MYERS stated she observed the unknown suspect go into the Walmart store, exit and go into a black security truck, with lights on it. MYERS stated she observed the unknown black male circle the lot a couple times, rolled down his window, and checked to see if she was still inside the vehicle. MYERS stated she was scared during this incident. MYERS stated she called Mikailya EGLE (white female, 1/12/01) who is employed by Pathfinders and notified her of the incident.

I interviewed EGLE who is a confidential advocate, who stated she received a phone call from MYERS at approximately 8:38am on 8/30/23 and described the incident. EGLE stated when she arrived at Walmart she observed MYERS alone in a blue Honda. ELGE did NOT get a plate number. EGLE then stated she assisted with transporting MYERS to Mt. Sanai for a medical evaluation.

On August 31st, 2023, I provided follow-up regarding this case to review security footage from Walmart at the address of 401 E Capital Dr, in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

I met with the security office within Walmart at this location and was able to review footage from August 30th, 2023, at the stated time of this incident.

To note: Descriptions involved were that the suspect was a black male with a bearded chin, thin eyebrows, driving a blue Honda vehicle. Victim in this case also stated that the suspect was working as a security guard for Walmart and began driving the company security car after the incident.

When I spoke to the security staff, they advised that it is uncommon for a male to be security in the morning, and that security starts at 6:00AM. When I advised that I will be looking at yesterday's footage (08-30-2023), the security employees stated that it actually was a male that worked yesterday, and that it is an individual that is not often working. The quote was "once in a blue moon." None of the workers at this time knew the name of the security guard working on 08-30-23 at 6:00AM.

The following are the findings regarding video footage I reviewed. All times are referred to being on the date of August 30th, 2023.

Prior to **5:50AM**, there are no individuals sitting or sleeping on the benches of Walmart within an hour timespan.

At the time of **5:48AM** a blue Honda sedan (possibly an Accord) arrives within the parking lot and parks (this car is later identified as being the on-duty security guard).

At **5:50AM** a white female who I identify as being the victim (MYERS) in this case per description of clothing as well as meeting the victim in person at Mt. Sinai Hospital.

A black male exits the blue Honda and first interacts with MYERS at the time of **5:55AM**. It appears as if it is conversational between the two individuals. There is no contact between the two or aggressive appearing behavior.

At the time of **5:57AM** both the black male and MYERS walk to the Blue Honda and get in. During this interaction, MYERS is approximately 4 to 5 steps behind the black male following him to the vehicle.

At **5:58AM** the black male leaves the vehicle without MYERS. MYERS is not observed exiting the vehicle.

At **6:00AM** the black male is observed at the front doors of Walmart (Northside doors to the West).

At **6:05AM** the black male is observed walking back to the blue Honda and sat into the driver seat. Both occupants stayed in the vehicle until **6:14AM**.

After **6:14AM** the security guard is observed around Walmart appearing to do regular duties.


