Subject: Intersection Modifications at
West Silver Spring Drive and
North Teutonia Avenue

Dear Council Members:

The intersection modifications at West Silver Spring Drive and North Teutonia Avenue are necessary to reduce the number of traffic accidents.

This project is eligible for Federal/State cost participation for improvements under the State Hazard Elimination Safety Program. We have requested and received preliminary approval from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) along with a project agreement to be executed by the City for design and construction.

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution which authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute the project agreement with the WISDOT for the design and construction of the intersection modifications at West Silver Spring Drive and North Teutonia Avenue with 90% Federal/State aid. This resolution also directs the City Comptroller to transfer funds and establish the necessary project/grant chartfield values for the preliminary engineering work for the project.
