Resolution celebrating the March Against Hate for the 30th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

WHEREAS,

MILWAUKEE COALITION AGAINST HATE AND THE ACCESSIBLE JUSTICE LEAGUE

celebrated the 30th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act on July 26, 2020 with the March Against Hate at Cahill Square Park in Whitefish Bay; and

WHEREAS, *July 26, 2020 marked the 30th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 which ensures people with disabilities are protected under the law to have the same rights and opportunities as all Americans, and prohibits discrimination against individuals with disabilities in all areas of public life; and*

WHEREAS, *The City of Milwaukee affirms the principals of equality and inclusion for persons with disabilities as set forth by the State of Wisconsin and as embodied in the ADA, the laws of the State of Wisconsin and ordinances of the City of Milwaukee; and*

WHEREAS, *Milwaukee Coalition Against Hate and the Accessible Justice League works with constituents and the community to bring forth the promise of hope and freedom that is envisioned by the passage of the ADA; and*

WHEREAS, *The March Against Hate hosted by Milwaukee Coalition Against Hate and the Accessible Justice League celebrated the 30th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act and continued the discussion within the community on Black Lives Matter, racial injustices, systemic racism, and police reform; and*

WHEREAS, *The City of Milwaukee celebrates the anniversary of the ADA and acknowledges the continuing commitment that needs to be made in order to reach the full potential of equality; now, therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, *That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith recognizes the 30th Anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act March Against Hate; and, be it*

FURTHER RESOLVED, *That a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution be presented to Milwaukee Coalition Against Hate and the Accessible Justice League.*
