Subject: Street Lighting
Mitchell Interchange Reconstruction
Phase 2

Dear Honorable Members:

Reconstruction of the Mitchell Interchange will include modifications to local streets. Due to the magnitude of this project, it is being divided into phases. This part of the second phase will affect the area around 1322 West Layton Avenue and 2105 West Van Norman and adjoining streets.

Street Lighting facility modifications being done in conjunction with this project will include, installation of two transformer enclosures (power sources for the street lighting) modifying permanent lighting, and the removal of the translosures. Funding for the street lighting work is provided by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) by means of a Local Force Account (LFA) contract.

One Hundred percent of the total cost will be funded by WISDOT.

The attached resolution authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a LFA contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install the interim lighting, permanent lighting improvements, and removal of the interim lighting in conjunction with the work in the above named areas.
