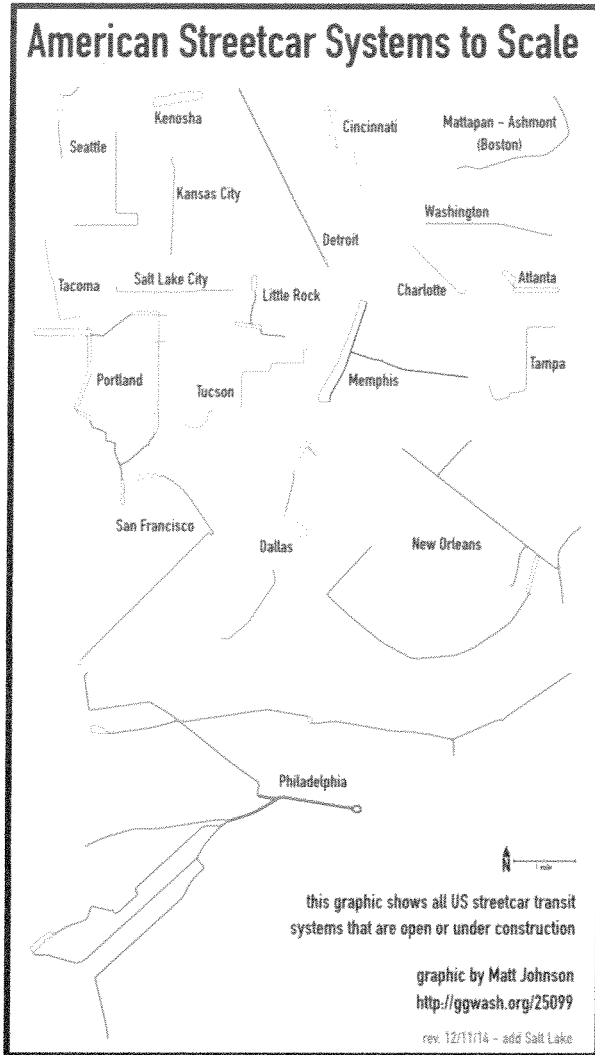


2015 Streetcar Summit Huge Success
