outstanding warrants. Mr. HARRIS, however, refused to open the door and subsequently fled through a window of the residence initiating a foot pursuit of the officers. Mr. HARRIS was eventually caught but resisted. Officers attempted to take him into custody but he refused to be handcuffed at which time he was directed to the ground, handcuffed and placed in custody.

It is complainant Lowmorreo A. HARRIS' account that when officers apprehended him he was told that he had a warrant for his arrest. He states that Officer BRAUNREITER then displayed what he described as a CJF photograph depicting Mr. HARRIS. He states that Officer BRAUNREITER inquired as to why he ran and then proceeded to strike him to the rear of his head with a flashlight. Additionally he states that an unknown officer then kicked him in the left side of his ribs. HARRIS denied any resistive acts and states that he was struck to the head and kicked in the ribs without provocation. Upon examination of HARRIS' head by Detective CISKE a small area of slight swolleness and spongeness was observed. HARRIS, however, declined any medical attention.

CONCLUSION:

All officers involved in this incident declined to give a statement. Complainant Lowmorreo HARRIS was charged with Resisting an Officer on Wednesday, June 30, 1999 the charge of Resisting an Officer was reviewed in the office of the District Attorney. ADA Stephanie ROTHSTEIN upon affording Mr. HARRIS an opportunity to offer his account of this incident did issue the charge of Resisting an Officer against Mr. HARRIS. Based upon said issuance and the account of HARRIS' actions at the time of his arrest, this case will be cleared as baseless.
