



- Increases the mileage rate from \$11.75 to \$12.00, the same level authorized for the MFD.
  - Increases the ancillary charges that may be billed by Privates by 15%, with the exception of oxygen, defibrillation supplies and non-transport fees (see above). These charges were last increased in 1999.
  - In regards to drug charges, the drugs allowed by the state of Wisconsin emergency medical technician basic scope of practice and approved by the Milwaukee county council on emergency medical services, shall be charged at the same rates established for the Fire Department under s. 75-15-17-d.
3. In regards to Advanced Life Support (ALS), this ordinance includes a ‘me too’ paragraph granting Privates that perform an advanced life support (ALS) conveyance under the terms of the Private Provider Interfacility Unit protocol permission to charge for those services using the MFD fee schedule pursuant to s. 75-15-17 a to d. These charges shall in no way be construed so as to circumvent the role of the fire department as the designated responder to ALS calls.

**Fiscal Impact**

The fiscal impact is nominal since police prisoner transport by private ambulance will be charged 60% of the established rate (charged to MPD in the event that the prisoner is unable to pay).
