Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 060792, which grants a special privilege to South West Imports, LLC for a barrier free access ramp with platform and handrail; two platforms each with a step; and three excess door swings to occupy the public right-of-way abutting the premises at 1035-39 West National Avenue.

The applicant is in the process of renovating the building at 1035-39 West National Avenue and is requesting permission to construct and maintain a concrete barrier free access ramp with platform and handrail, which will serve a new doorway and make the first floor restaurant space accessible. The ramp with platform and handrail will project 5 feet into the east 15-foot wide sidewalk area of South 11<sup>th</sup> Street and will be 22 feet 6 inches long. A 10-foot wide clear path will remain for pedestrians after the ramp is built.

A site visit revealed the presence of two concrete platforms, each having one-step. Both platforms project 3 feet 2 inches into the 15-foot wide east sidewalk area of South 11<sup>th</sup> Street. The south platform is 6 feet 1 inch long and the north platform is 5 feet long. A 3-foot wide door swings open over each of the platforms and into the public way in excess of the 12 inches allowed under Section 245-4.8 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

We are not aware that the presence of said items has had or will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said items to occupy the public right-of-way.
