There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this no

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

The officer observed 6 electronic gambling machines with a sign affixed that stated "No cash outs under \$20 before leaving".

5. On 02/14/2020 at 2:25am officers were dispatched to a Sick/Injured complaint at 261 E. Hampton Av. When the officer arrived they found Whitefish Bay Police on scene with an intoxicated subject, lying on his side throwing up on the ground. The subject was conveyed to the hospital for treatment. The officer went to Alioto's to investigate, finding the front door locked. Upon entering they observed 4 people inside with alcohol and money on the top of the bar. The officers spoke with the bartender who stated the intoxicated subject had been in the bar and had left about 30 minutes prior to the officer's arrival. The bartender stated 2 of the people in the bar were employees but they had gotten off work at midnight. One of the patrons in the bar attempted to leave but was too intoxicated to walk, so the officers conveyed him home. A check of the license revealed the bar had a closing time of 1:30am. On 02/19/2020 the officer spoke with the applicant regarding the situation. He stated he did not know why the license had a closing time of 1:30am. The applicant was cited for Allow Patron After Hours and the bartender was cited for over serving a patron.

6. On11/23/20 at 10:53P, officers conducted a License Premise Check at Aliota's, 261 E. Hampton. Officers spoke to an employee who did not have a Class D Operator License, however, was under supervision of an employee that held a license. The employee was instructed to obtain her license as soon as possible.

7. On 01/31/21 at 9:28P, officers were dispatched to Aliota's, 261 E. Hampton Av., for a DUI complaint. Officers located a citizen in the rear parking lot of the establishment outside of the vehicle, appearing to be intoxicated. Officers spoke to the passenger who stated they had been drinking in the bar earlier and were trying to leave when the driver fell in the snow and lost the keys. Due to weather conditions and level of intoxication the officers conveyed the citizen's home. The officers returned to the bar and located the keys in the snow. This license premise report is written by PO Nora BURLO, assigned to District Five, Late Power Shift, Sq. 5468 with PO James TERRELL.

On 5/18/23 at 10:28PM we were dispatched to a Subject With Gun Complaint at the address 261 E Hampton Av. The listed address is a Aliota's Pub & Grill, which is a licensed premises in the city of Milwaukee.

Prior to officer arrival, the anonymous caller stated a male subject was on scene with a gun in his waistband. The caller refused to provide a full description of the male subject.

Upon arrival I was approached by a w/m subject who stated he was the caller but refused to identify himself to me. He then stated the male subject he called about was on scene and near PO TERRELL, he still refused to provide a description of the male subject. The w/m subject stated he observed a firearm in the waistband of the subject near PO TERRELL prior to officer arrival on scene. He stated there were no threats made and the individual never pointed the firearm at anyone.

PO TERRELL made contact with a b/m subject, who identified himself as Darrell L BONDS (b/m, 2/7/60). BONDS stated officers were on scene to harass him because he is a black man. He stated he did not brandish a firearm or threaten anyone. He stated he did not know why officers were called for him.

BONDS was ultimately conveyed to his residence.

Prior to officers conveying BONDS to his residence, I entered Aliota's Pub & Grill to speak with the bartender and gather licensing information.

I made contact with the solo bartender who identified herself as Jessica M BEVERLY (w/f, 9/22/82). BEVERLY asked if officers would drive BONDS (who she pointed to through a window), home. I informed her we would, and she thanked me. I then asked for the licensing information.

BEVERLY then directed me to an area near the cash register.

I observed the business's licenses.

Food Dealer Restaurant (#0017751) which will expire 7/27/23. Class B Tavern (#0210397) which will also expire on 7/27/23. BEVERLY also provided me with her Class D Operator's License (#0233311).

All else inside of the listed location appeared orderly and clean.



The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 7/9/2024 at 1:25 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
