Is estimated to total \$1.86 million. The gain in revenue due to the increase in time zone violation forfeitures is estimated to total \$350,000. The net loss in revenue is estimated to total \$1.5 million annually which would reduce the Parking Fund's payment to the General Fund by the same amount.
