No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

- **The driver over charged me saying that \$20 was a deal since I wanted to go to the east side of Milwaukee. He was rude and held his phone in his hand while driving.**

I called Easy Cab to get a ride from _____ on Friday, August 8. I left a message and I was called me back at 3:26pm by Singh Harpreet. I told them I needed an SUV since I had crutches to help walk. He stated a driver will be there in five minutes.

The driver showed up and we got in the SUV. He started driving and I told him I wanted to go to Judy's on North (Judy's Cantina) and gave him street names. He raised his voice and said I need an address. My son looked up the address and him or I gave it to him. He said it would be \$20. I said "\$20, that's high to go to the

east side." He said that is a good deal. I excepted since we were already in the vehicle and 6 blocks from my home and I didn't want to be put out and not able to walk back home. I made sure I looked at the rate sticker that was on his dashboard: \$2.50 base rate, .25/.10miles and \$1 for extra passenger, so I could calculate the actual price when I got home. While he was driving, he had his phone in his hand scrolling for music and his phone began to play music. I asked him to please put the phone down while he was driving. He put it down, next to him, but still was looking at it for directions. When we were close to the restaurant, he picked it up again. I paid him once we got to the restaurant with my check card. I asked him for a receipt. He handed me his phone and I typed in my email address and gave it back to him. I asked him to press the send receipt button. I do not know if he pressed the button and a receipt was sent yet.

Saturday morning, I researched the exact prices for taking a taxi in Milwaukee and used what was on his dashboard to calculate the actual cost to get to the restaurant. His route driving down North Avenue was 3.7 miles. The cost should have been \$12.75:

base rate:	\$2.50
25 cents/.10 mile =	\$9.25
extra passenger	<u>\$1.00</u>
	\$12.75

He over charged me by \$7.25.

I call the cab company and got the driver's name by telling him I wanted to praise him. I hung up and researched how to file a complaint. I then called the cell number for **Singh Harpreet**. I told him that his driver over charged me and I wanted a refund or I would file a complaint. He said the driver would be there in 10 minutes. My son reminded me that they should not be coming to my home. I called the number back and told him to keep the money and I would be lodging a complaint and hung up. He called back and my son answered and told him not to call here again.
