Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 091114

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 091114, being a resolution to amend a special privilege to Pipito Inc for removal of a popcorn wagon and for addition of six moveable planters in the public right-of-way for the premises at 7718-20 West Burleigh Street.

Pipito Inc d/b/a Mama Mia Restaurant requested permission to keep and maintain a popcorn wagon, two covered walks, and four moveable planters in the public right-of-way. Permission for said items was granted in 1992 under Common Council Resolution File Number 921064. Subsequently, the popcorn wagon was removed from the public right-of-way.

A site visit revealed the presence of six additional moveable planters in the north, 10-foot wide sidewalk area of West Burleigh Street. The 4-foot diameter concrete planters are centered approximately 9 feet south of the northline of West Burleigh Street and are evenly spaced between the westline of North 77th Street and a point approximately 200 feet to the west.

We are not aware that the presence of said items will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will remove the popcorn wagon from the special privilege and allow said planters and covered walks to continue to occupy the public right-of-way.
