Description of workBrady Street Hardware has been a long term tenant in this building but has now closed. A new tenant is moving into the building and will be operating a restaurant. The tenant proposes to replace the current single paned storefront windows with insulated glass. He also wants openable windows for his patrons.

New awnings will be installed in the location of the existing awnings but have the name of the new business "Harry's on Brady".


The new storefront windows will be the same size as current but with metal frames. There will be thermal glazing but no tinted glass. The new windows will lift and tilt in and up, thus preserving the bulkhead area and the current wood openings and trim around the window openings.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 
