File # 080852 is a resolution amending the resolution at File #080020, adopted May 20, 2008, relating to the application, acceptance and funding of the Medical Assistance Outreach-BadgerCare Plus Grant from Community Advocates.

Background

- This new program provides assistance to City of Milwaukee residents in making application for BadgerCare Plus medical insurance, food stamps and other entitlements.
- 2. Medical Assistance Outreach activities have been funded in the past through the Greater Milwaukee Foundation and the Social Development Commission.

Discussion

- 1. The grant period is May 1, 2008, through October 31, 2008.
- 2. Funding authorized by File #080020 was \$20,000 to process 400 applications at \$50 per application. The proposed amendment increases authorized funding and expenditures by \$5,000, wholly grantor funded.
- 3. The initial and proposed amended budget partially supports one existing Public Health Educator II for the grant period as follows:

- 4. The resolution in File #080852 authorizes the City Comptroller to commit an additional \$5,000 grantor share funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2008 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects Fund and to create appropriate Special Revenue Fund-Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project /Grant levels.
- 5. The resolution further authorizes the Health Department, consistent with the terms of the grant, to: expend from these budgeted amounts; enter into subcontracts and leases; to expend 2008 budgeted grants for equipment deemed necessary to the operation of the program; and to expend funds for training and out-of-town travel of departmental staff from the grant funds in 2008.

6. All other resolved clauses in File #080020 remain in effect as adopted.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. This amended budget will provide a total of \$5,000 in additional non-O&M funding support for activities and services that would not otherwise be provided.
- 2. There is no impact on the tax levy.
