There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffit, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

On Friday, April 05, 2024 at 11:54 a.m. my partner P.O. Richard TOLENTINO and I was dispatched to 2500 W. Lisbon Ave regarding a battery complaint.

Upon arrival I spoke to the caller / licensed premise clerk who identified himself as Ala ISSA (W/M, 04-02-1997) who stated a male came inside of the store and refused to leave after a prolonged period of time. ISSA called from the Bright Food Market telephone 414-342-2121. ISSA stated he asked the unknown subject to leave multiple times. ISSA stated the male opened the clerks door and began throwing store product on the ground and damaging merchandise. ISSA stated he called the Police and waited for police arrival. ISSA indicated the subject fled in an unknown direction.

The business was cooperative with the investigation and did not have any security officers present.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During my investigation I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

ISSA indicated he was unable to show us the surveillance video due to him not having the password for the system.

The ultimate outcome to this call was to issue a citation to the unknown subject once he was identified.

No police action was taken against the business.

This report is written by P.O. Ryan MILLER, assigned to District 3, Day Shift.

On 5-8-24, P.O. Abran RAMIREZ and I (Squad 3142) were dispatched to 2500 W Lisbon AV for a burglary complaint. Upon arrival, I observed the location to be a corner store. We were met by the Bright Food Market employee Ala I ISSA (W/M, 4-2-97) who stated their store was broken into overnight. ISSA is the manager at this location.

ISSA stated he arrived on scene at approximately 6:00 AM and observed their front gate and front door forced open. ISSA stated the front security gate appeared sawed open and the front door appeared pried open with a crowbar or other similar object. ISSA stated that the location had video surveillance of the incident. ISSA also stated he had been provided video surveillance from next door at 2520 W Lisbon AV. ISSA showed us this video, which depicted the suspect vehicle fleeing the scene.

The video surveillance from the store showed an unknown subject arrive at approximately 3:37 AM and force entry to the business. This suspect was seen sawing the front gate open with an electric saw. The suspect then used a crowbar to pry open the front door. Once inside, the suspect used the same crowbar to force open the door to the register area. The suspect then removed several items of property from the location.

The video surveillance from 2520 W Lisbon AV showed the suspect fleeing the scene w/b on W Lisbon AV in a yellow van. ISSA provided us with surveillance video from both locations. These videos were uploaded to evidence.com. It did appear that the timestamps from the incident location were slightly off. ISSA and the business were extremely cooperative, and their camera footage was good. It appeared that all cameras inside and outside the location were functioning properly. ISSA was able to provide us access to their surveillance system immediately on scene. There were no security officers on scene. ISSA stated their security company notified them of the possible break-in one hour after the incident time.

CIB did not respond to handle the investigation.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
