The beaches are under Milwaukee County jurisdiction, and as part of their robust efforts under the Office of Equity, County Parks uses four data sources, CDC Social Vulnerability Index, Personal Crime Index (federal census and AGS data), Tree Canopy Data (LiDAR/Milwaukee County Land Information Office), and a "10-Minute Walk Analysis" (Trust for Public Lands) to create an Equity Index Score.
