Also, I was on my way of town and I tried to resolve this when I got back. It wasn't anything wrong with the car because I will drive the car around the block to keep the battery from running. The only reason the tires were flat, these bad kids in the neighborhood keep letting the air out. Furthermore, If you look at the police calls I made concerning shots being fired or someone stealing cars stripping them in the back of my house, so that is why I didn't park my car in the back.
