9. On 01/03/19 at 2:41am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1840 N. 6th Street for an armed robbery complaint. Investigation revealed that the caller/victim, who works at 1840 N. 6th Street, was 408 W. North Avenue when the incident occurred. The victim stated that he was at the filling station when he was approached by a subject with his hands under his hooded sweatshirt. Fearing for his safety, the victim pulled out his firearm for protection and the subject ran. The victim is a CCW holder and went to work before calling police.
10. On 08/08/19 at 10:00pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 408 W. North Avenue for a trouble with subject complaint. Upon arrival, officers interviewed the caller who stated that she was having a conversation with two panhandlers inside the filling station who wanted her to buy them a charger. The employee locked the panhandlers out of the establishment by closing the metal gate to the entrance of the store. This action made the caller feel like a prisoner and she felt that it was unwarranted. She also felt like the employee believed that she stole items from the store to help the panhandlers. The caller said that she will be at the licensing meeting to speak about the incident.

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11. On 12/19/2020 at 9:11pm officers conducted a license premise check at US Gas & Food Mart, 408 W. North Av. The officers located several expired food items throughout the store. The clerk was advised of the items and stated he would remove them from the shelves. The officers also observed two video gaming machines. The machines were plugged in and operating. The business did not have a PEP license. The officers contacted the applicant and advised him of the expired items and the unlicensed gaming machines. The applicant stated the machines are leased and he would take care of the expired items.

12. On 03/08/2021 at 3:12pm officers were dispatched to a Property Damage at US Gas & Food Mart, 408 W. North Av. The officer arrived on scene and observed a subject actively destroying items inside the store. The subject was arrested. The officers interviewed the clerk, who stated the subject refused to pay for items so they locked the door. The subject then began destroying the store.

13. On 07/11/2021 officers were dispatched to a subject with gun at US Gas & Food Mart, 408 W. North Av. The caller was the clerk, who stated a customer became upset and displayed a firearm, pointing at him. The officer observed video of the incident, which showed the customer producing a pistol and tapping it on the bullet proof glass. The clerk stayed behind the glass and the subject left when the clerk called the police. The clerk stated he wanted to prosecute.

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14. On 08/26/21 the applicant was cited at 4295 W Roosevelt Dr., for Assault and Battery.

15. On 06/04/22 at 1:36pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 408 W. North Avenue for a robbery complaint. Upon arrival, officers interviewed the workers who said they did not know of a robbery until the victim entered the store and told them he had been robbed. Surveillance footage captured the robbery which occurred in the parking lot of that location. Staff was cooperative with the investigation.
16. On 07/23/22 at 9:10am, a victim walked into the Fifth District Station House to report a theft. He told officers that he was at 408 W. North Avenue waiting for an Uber when he was approached by two subjects who said, "Give me everything you got." The victim gave the subjects his property. There was nothing of evidentiary value on the surveillance video.
17. On 08/07/22 at 8:11am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 408 W. North Avenue for an armed robbery complaint (original call was received by the Police at 2:53am). Surveillance footage revealed that two subjects approach the front window on the east side of the store and fire several shots at the window, then run northbound out of camera range. Since the window is made of bullet resistant material, 6 rounds hit the window, but did not go through.
18. On 09/04/22 at 3:15am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 408 W. North Avenue for a shots fired complaint. Investigation revealed that someone had fired shots just north of the gas pumps.
19. On 09/26/22 at 3:30am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 408 W. North Avenue for an entry complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject threw a rock through the front window, breaking it, and took merchandise. The employee was cooperative and allowed officers to view surveillance footage.
20. On 11/28/22 at 7:29p.m., officers were dispatched to a Shooting at 408 W. North Av. On arrival officers observed the victim pulseless and not breathing with multiple gun shots to their body in the parking lot. Video surveillance depicted the victim exit the store and 3 suspects opened fire on the victim, shooting him at least 28 times. The employees were cooperative stating they did not see the incident, however, did hear the gunfire and upon observing the victim, they called for police.
21. On 01/18/23 at 6:56am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 408 W. North Avenue for a trouble with subject complaint. Investigation revealed that a customer was in a dispute with the clerk over gas money. The clerk refunded the customer.
22. On 02/07/23 at 9:15am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 408 W. North Avenue for an accident complaint. Investigation revealed that a vehicle drove over the hose of a tanker truck while it was refueling the filling station. The striking vehicle left the scene before police arrived.

23. On 03/06/23 at 11:45am, a virtual Teams meeting was held regarding the location of 408 W. North Avenue. The property was declared a nuisance property with a billing cycle end date of 09/01/23. Topics discussed during the meeting were; instructions on when employees should be contacting the police, educating employees on "no loitering" enforcement, and vehicles loitering in the parking lot. The applicant was receptive to the discussion but expressed frustration on how he is unable to control the actions of people outside his store and vehicles speeding down W. North Avenue. The officer offered to place a speed board in the area and to perform a CPTED on his business. The applicant accepted both offers.

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24. On 06/08/23 at 8:00pm, officer working in conjunction with Wisconsin WINNS Youth Tobacco Prevention, conducted a compliance check at 408 W. North Av. The 17 year old buyer was allowed to purchase a tobacco product from the business. Officers spoke with the cashier who was apologetic for the sale. The agent was cited regarding the sale.

25. On 12/15/23 at 4:22am, officers were dispatched to 408 W. North Av, for a sick/injured complaint. Officers located a subject outside the business un responsive but breathing. The business was cooperative with the investigation. The employee was unable to provide video but the day employee could provide officers video access.

26. On 12/16/23 at 1:31am, officers were dispatched to 408 W. North Av, for a sick/injured complaint. Officers spoke with the caller who stated that she observed a subject outside the business un responsive but breathing. The caller stated that he was near the gas pumps. Officer attempted to look over video footage, but the employee was unable to provide video. Officers were informed the day employee could provide video access.

27. On 05/24/24 at 9:15am, officers were dispatched to 408 W. North Av, for a shot fired complaint. Officers located 12 casing outside the business location. No victims were located regarding the shots fired. The business was cooperative with the investigation providing video of the incident. The video showed the incident in its entirety, the suspects, and suspect vehicle's information.

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Item #24 updated with disposition

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The following calls for police service pertain to 408 W. North Ave.

28. On 10/07/24 at 805pm., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Robbery. Investigation revealed the victim was pulled out of their vehicle by an unknown suspect after pumping gas. The suspect then fled the scene with the victim's vehicle. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident. There were no security officers on scene.

29. On 12/05/24 at 905pm., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Armed Robbery. Investigation revealed while the victim was sitting in their vehicle, an unknown suspect approached, displayed a firearm, and told the victim to get out of the vehicle, then fled with the victim's vehicle. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident. There were no security officers on scene.
30. On 02/14/25 at 210am., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Theft. Investigation revealed a suspect snatched the victim's car keys out of their hand, while they were inside the business, then fled with the victim's vehicle. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident. There were no security officers on scene.
31. On 03/31/25 at 922pm., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check. No violations were found other than a few expired items. The business was cooperative.
32. On 04/29/25 at 458am., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Overdose. On arrival officers observed the victim foaming and spitting inside the business. MFD was on scene and the subject was conveyed to a hospital for medical clearance.
33. On 05/21/25 at 816pm., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting that occurred at 324 W. North Ave. Investigation revealed the incident began inside of 408 W. North Ave., and an employee's vehicle was struck by gunfire. The officers did locate 2 casings near the south entrance of the building. A witness stated the suspect vehicle was seen leaving the gas station. A victim was located at 324 W. North Ave., and pronounced deceased at the scene. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

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The following items are related to 408 W. North Ave.

34. On 07/18/25, at 2:12 a.m., officers were dispatched to an Armed Robbery. The victim reported on 07/17/25, at 9:09 p.m., he was at the business sitting in his vehicle. Two suspects approached him, pointed a long gun and demanded his property.
35. On 01/02/26, at 9:06p.m., officers were dispatched to a Threat complaint. An unknown subject threatened to harm an employee due to an incident with a family member that was stealing, which they believed was handled too aggressively.

This report is written by Police Officer VUE, Sonic assigned to District 5, Late Shift, Squad 5390.

On July 18, 2025, approximately 2:12 AM, PO SOSA and I were dispatched to 2224 N 7th St located in the city and county of Milwaukee for an armed robbery with AXON body camera activated while wearing full police uniform.

INITIAL OBSERVATION

Upon our arrival, I observed the building to be a white ranch style house at the back of the address 2224 N 7th St located in the city and county of Milwaukee with the main entrance door facing West. I made contact and met the victim identified as Vell L. DAVIS (B/M 04/01/1966).

VICTIM'S INTERVIEW

DAVIS stated that on July 17, 2025, 9:09 PM, DAVIS went to the Citgo gas station, located at 408 W North Av located in the city and county of Milwaukee, to get cigarettes and scratch off tickets. Once DAVIS purchased the cigarettes and scratch off tickets, DAVIS went into his 2002 White GMC Sonoma (LW7792) passenger side to put his scratch off tickets in his bible.

While sitting in his vehicle, DAVIS stated that suspect 1 opened his passenger door and placed a long rifle barrel into his right-side lower rib area. Suspect 1 stated, "Let me get that old man." and began patting his front right pants pocket. DAVIS stated that the suspect 1 was a B/M, around 16-19 years of age, approximately 5'1", around 120 lbs, wearing a dark blue hooded jacket with a black baseball cap, and royal blue short. DAVIS stated that the long rifle was a black AK-47 style firearm.

DAVIS then stated that suspect 2 opened the right driver side door and pointed a long barrel AK-47 style firearm into his left-side lower rib area. The suspect 2 stated to DAVIS, "Let me get that" and grabbed DAVIS's wallet on the left back pants pocket and DAVIS's cigarette and scratch off tickets in his hooded jacket. DAVIS described suspect 2 being a 5'5" B/M, around 16-19 years of age, approximately 110 lbs, black shirt, and black short.

DAVIS then stated suspect 3 came at the driver side, next to the suspect 2, and began searching the car and DAVIS's front hooded jacket pocket while having an AK-47 style rifle. DAVIS stated that the suspect 3 told DAVIS, "Let me get that." DAVIS described suspect 3 being a 5'5" B/M, around 16-19 years of age,

approximately 110 lbs, and wearing a white shirt.

Once suspects had DAVIS's wallet, all three suspects ran out and scattered in different direction. DAVIS stepped out of the vehicle and contacted police to respond to the location. Davis then stated that he came home due to squad not responding to the call.

Davis stated that he had \$500, 2 EBT cards, 2 Visa card that is not activated, a MasterCard that was also not activated, and 2 WI identification cards one being expired. All items were inside of a dark blue bifold wallet which DAVIS stated it cost approximately \$10.

2 cameras on the inner south side of the building facing south into the gas pumps.

I contact the clerk inside of Citgo. Individual was identified as Gurjot SINGH (A/M 06/05/2001) through Canadian Identification Card. SINGH stated that he started work at 8:00 PM-7:00 AM and SINGH did not see the incident. SINGH was cooperated and attempted to login into the surveillance system to help find the footage of the incident. SINGH stated that officers should come back in the morning of 7/18/2025 to get video footage from the clerk.

I looked at the camera system and I observed the camera was captured on Camera 4 and Camera 8.

Commercial building which includes the gas station and a Boost Mobile store. Location has 6 gas pumps. Gas pump 2 is located at the east side of the lot. There are three entrances into the gas station, 1 located by N Vel R. Phillips and 2 entrances by W North Av.

This report is written by P.O. DanYatta BROWN assigned to District 5 Late Power Shift, Squad 5448.

On January 02,2026, at approximately 9:06 P.M my partner P.O. DeAngelo JUNIOR and I were dispatched to 408 W North Ave for a Threat complaint located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon our arrival I spoke with the caller who is a clerk at the gas station, who identified by identification card as Sirpreet SINGH (W/M 09/08/2003), phone number 414-312-7151. SINGH stated the family of a juvenile has come to the location making verbal threats regarding a situation that occurred with the juvenile stealing from the location earlier in the day. The family felt as though the juvenile was handled too rough, and there were bruises after their altercation of retrieving their property back. Family members came to the above listed location to confront SINGH about it, and made threats to beat him up when he comes outside.

The business was cooperative with the investigation.

The business had 0 security officers on scene.

I reviewed video surveillance footage. The footage showed at 8:54P.M an unknown black female wearing a black jacket, black and white leggings, black and white shoes was inside of the location along with a B/M wearing a black hat, colorful jacket, gold and black pajama pants with white shoes, and another B/F wearing a black hat, black coat, black track pants with red stripes on the side, wearing black Jordans with white bottoms. The video showed the female with the black and white leggings arguing with SINGH through the glass, and SINGH arguing back. There was no one on scene at the time of our arrival, but later the grandmother of the juvenile arrived outside along with the juvenile, expressing her concern about the incident that occurred earlier with him stealing. The grandmother was advised to leave the property and to not return.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During my investigation for a Threat, I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

Upon arrival I spoke with the victim of the incident who identified himself as Sparsh SINGH (A/M 09/08/2003) who stated on March 15th, 2026, he was working at the Citgo gas station located at 408 W North Ave. At 11:15PM an unknown suspect entered into the business and was irate while speaking with someone on the phone. The suspect then began an argument with SINGH at 11:19PM. SINGH stated the man told him "I'm gonna shoot you" and "Come outside I'm going to shoot you, you have to come out sometime." while the man was making threats, he pulled out a loaded magazine and showed it to SINGH. This was captured on CCTV footage which is located throughout the store. SINGH stated that the man also reached into his sweatshirt and pointed a small handgun at him. SINGH stated these actions caused him to fear for his life and that the suspect waited in the parking lot for several minutes waiting for SINGH to leave.

I reviewed the CCTV video footage which shows a black male approximately 40 years old wearing a white shirt and gray hoodie with a black stitched pattern on the back. There is clear video footage of the man's face as he approaches the counter. The man can be seen yelling at SINGH and reaching into his jacket and removing a loaded magazine. The man then points the magazine at SINGH. The man later leaves the building and goes to the parking lot and gets into a dark gray Honda Civic without a front license plate. The man waits in the vehicle until 11:35PM when he drives westbound on W North Ave. I asked SINGH to upload these videos to evidence.com as well as a video taken on SINGH's phone which shows the subject making threats to harm SINGH and reaching into his hoodie which appears to conceal a firearm. SINGH stated that he has seen the subject around and that he was concerned for the lives of everyone in the store, because the man was making threats to other customers as well. The other customers had left the scene by the time I arrived.

SINGH was given a PV-17 and a community contact card and advised to call police if the subject returns. I was unable to retrieve the video footage from the business' CCTV camera. SINGH later uploaded footage to Evidence.com of the suspect in the incident. All parties were cooperative with police investigation.
