Please accept for introduction at the meeting of January 18, 2006, the attached file related to the Fire Department's application for the "Community Involvement Project" grant from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

If awarded, this grant will allow the department to build upon its fire education programs through the establishment of a new community-based program focused on reducing the number of residential fire-related injuries and fatalities in high-risk communities.

The five-year grant program will establish two fire prevention safety communities per year for a total of ten (10) communities over the grant period. Per the application submitted, the Milwaukee Fire Department has identified two high-risk communities within the 7th Aldermanic district for the first year of this grant program and has developed a program implementation plan.
