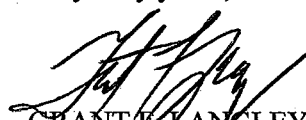
Dear Council Members:

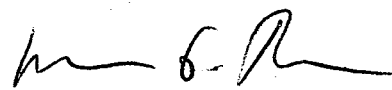
We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, Tracy Reynolds, 3730 North 2nd Street, Milwaukee, WI 53212, alleges on his own behalf that he sustained damage to his vehicle on April 27, 2002 when a portion of a City tree fell across it while parked in front of his residence. He claims damages in the amount of \$15,834.98.

Our investigation reveals this loss occurred as a result of high winds and was not in any way related to negligence by the City of Milwaukee. Accordingly, we recommend that this claim be denied.
