**Uninsured Motorist Claim Under Sec. 62.67 Stats.**



**REASON FOR REQUEST:**

Thomas Johnson, City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was travelling east on West State Street. As the City vehicle proceeded through the intersection of West State Street and North 10<sup>th</sup> Street, the uninsured motorist, who was travelling north on North 10<sup>th</sup> Street, failed to yield the right away and proceeded through a red traffic signal, striking the police vehicle causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to § 62.67 Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance plan.

Officer Johnson sustained injuries to his shoulders, neck and hip. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$7,740.77.
