Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 10/08/2020 at 6:15pm officers were dispatched to Pick N Save at 3701 S 27th St for a Retail Theft. The officers spoke with the manager, who stated the suspect was no longer on scene.
2. On 11/24/2020 at 7:30pm officers were dispatched to a Theft complaint at Pick N. Save, 3701 S 27th St. The officer spoke with the manager, who stated a subject exited the store with a small basket of merchandise that she did not pay for. The manager gave the officer a license plate number, which did not list to the described vehicle. The manager could not access the video but stated she would drop off a copy of the video at a later time.
3. On 11/24/2020 at 7:49pm officers were dispatched to a Theft complaint at Pick N. Save, 3701 S 27th St. The officers spoke with the manager, who pointed out a subject to the officers that was observed concealing meat in his jacket. The officers stopped the subject and issued him a citation.

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4. On 12/24/20 at 11:30am, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Injured/Sick complaint. Officers were advised an intoxicated subject was being conveyed to the hospital for treatment.

5. On 01/01/21 at 7:31pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Trouble with Subject complaint. Security advised officers they wanted a known subject that was not allowed on the premise to be removed. No violations were observed.

Officers were advised by the manager that an employee's father continuously calls the store to check on her, as there are trust issues. The father became irate when he was told by an employee they did not know the whereabouts of his daughter. The father then made physical threats to harm the manager. The manager did not want citations issued. The subject was advised not to enter or contact the store via telephone.
8. On 03/01/21 at 6:35pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Trouble with Subject complaint. Officers were advised by management a subject was causing a disturbance in the store by yelling and throwing items. The subject was arrested and issued a citation.
9. On 03/05/21 at 4:10pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Threat complaint. Officers were advised by management that an employee's father continuously calls the store and verbally threatens the staff. The caller was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.
10. On 03/06/21 at 9:40pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Threat complaint. Officers were advised by management that known subjects, who had previously been banned, entered the store and took merchandise valued at approximately \$75 and walked past the last point of purchase without paying. No violations were found.
11. On 03/14/21 at 10:50am, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for an attempted theft. Officers were advised a known subject entered the store and attempted to steal items. The subject fled the scene, however, was later apprehended by Police and arrested for Theft and Trespassing.
12. On 03/14/21 at 3:20pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for an attempted Theft. Officers were advised a subject entered the store and concealed alcohol and fled the store. The alcohol was later retrieved by security.

Officers were advised by the manager that a customer entered the store and told another customers children she would fight them. The subject was confronted by management, asked to sign a form banning her from the store due to her behavior. The customer signed it and exited the store, however, stood outside the property. The officers interviewed the subject, who was known to them as having mental issues. The subject stated she was only playing with the kids and voluntarily left the scene.
15. On 04/28/21 at 1:50pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Retail Theft. Officers were advised that a subject entered the store and placed approximately \$400 worth of merchandise in a shopping cart, then left the store past the last point of purchase, without paying. The subject then grabbed whatever items he could from the cart and fled in a vehicle. Management was cooperative, allowing officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
16. On 06/12/21 at 3:12pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Theft. Officers were advised two subjects entered the liquor department and filled a backpack with liquor despite multiple employees present and requests for them to return the liquor. The subjects were followed outside by security and upon fleeing in a vehicle, threw a can of Red Bull at one of the employees. Employees were cooperative with the investigation and provided surveillance video of the incident.
17. On 07/02/21 at 5:05pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Trouble with Subject. Officers were advised a known subject entered the liquor store and was observed concealing a bottle on his person. The subject was confronted and fled the store. Management were able to point out the subject's vehicle and where the subject had fled on foot to the officers. The subject was later apprehended by police and issued citations. No violations were found.
18. On 07/10/21 at 6:03am, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a retail Theft. Officers were advised a known shoplifter took a bottle of Downy and left the store past the last point of purchase without paying. The subject was located and issued a citation.

Management was cooperative and advised police they would review surveillance and contact police if there was any further information.

Officers detained the suspect, who was found to have multiple unpaid food items on his person, as well as merchandise with security tags on it from another store. The suspect was cited and released. The employees were cooperative with the investigation.

The officers interviewed the subject who refused police or medical services.

The customer became argumentative and was eventually asked to leave the store, at which time the customer threatened to come back with people to fight. The customer remained on scene and stated they were assaulted; however, the employees were cooperative and allowed officers to view video surveillance, which did not show any type of assault. The customer eventually left the scene.
 31. On 07/01/23 at 3:01p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Theft at 3701 S. 27th St. Investigation revealed a subject entered the store and took merchandise without paying.
 32. On 07/08/23 at 6:51p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 3701 S. 27th St. Investigation revealed the store manager believed a customer to have taken merchandise without paying and place it in their backpack. The manager then stopped the customer and took the backpack; however, store security and the cashier advised the manager, the customer had in fact paid for the merchandise. The customer became upset and punched the manager two times in the back of the head and took their backpack and left. The manager stated they could have handled the incident better. Video surveillance was available, however, not viewed by the officers.

The employees were cooperative and provided video surveillance of the incident.

On 08/10/2023 P.O David BUI (squad 3235) responded to a entry complaint located at 2355 N 35th street (Pick N Save) in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Caller Statements prior to call: CLLR STATES ONE OF THE EMPLOYEES HAD HIS CAR BROKEN INTO LAST NIGHT AND FEW ITEMS WERE STOLEN, ONE BEING A COMPUTER//STORE DOES HAVE INCIDENT ON VIDEO

Upon my arrival I spoke with the caller Jeffrey D DOLATA (M/W 03/31/1968) who stated at approximately 9:00PM on on 08/14/23 he parked work vehicle his vehicle a (white 2020 GMC Savana license plate number XE 21559) in the parking lot of the above listed residence. DOLATA stated at approximately 10:13AM he exited the above listed business and found his vehicle front drivers side window broken and his Dell Latitude 5430 valued at \$1000 removed from the front seat of his vehicle. It should be noted that I observed the front drivers side window broken. It should also be noted that DOLATA works as a maintenance worker for Pick N Save and drives the above listed vehicle daily.

While doing a canvass of the area I observed the Pick N Save business has cameras facing the incident. Brad L BANDL (M/W 10/06/1988) (Pick N Save manager) was able to recover a small video portion of the incident. I viewed the camera footage which showed a white dodge Durango arriving at the above listed residence at approximately 9:58AM and park next to DOLATA'S vehicle. I then observed a unknown suspects exit the vehicle and walk around DOLATA'S vehicle. I observed another unknown suspect exit the Durango and attempt to enter the passenger side of DELANT'S vehicle, but the video footage stopped prior to the suspects fleeing the scene.

It should be noted due to the video footage I was unable to clearly get a description of the unknown suspects, but I was able to observe that both suspects were wearing dark clothing.

P.O BUI processed the vehicle for prints and took 15 photos of the scene and recovered the video footage. Due to DOLATA entering the vehicle cleaning up the broken glass along with moving other items around of the evidence the original scene could not be documented. DOLATA has Ace American insurance. P.O BUI and I attempted to locate a vehicle matching the description of the unknown suspects vehicle, but was unsuccessful.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/28/2023 at 9:45 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
