

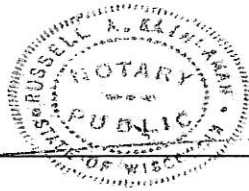

Pursuant to law, the Common Council has scheduled the Neighborhood Improvement District No. 9 (Havenwoods) Annual Meeting for, Wednesday, January 17th, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at Redemption Lutheran Church, 5681 N. 68th St., Milwaukee, Wisconsin, at which time the election of Neighborhood Improvement District board members will be considered.

This notice declares that all individuals who either own or occupy real property within the District are eligible to serve on the Board and vote at the election. The method of electing members to the District Board is cited in Section II.D (9) in the Neighborhood Improvement District Number Nine (NID #9) initial year operating plan, for the area bounded by N. 55th Place to N. 76th St. from Silver Spring Drive through Kaul Avenue with the following exclusions being public spaces and industrial uses: Carmen to Kaul Avenue from N. 55th St. to N. 60th St. and Florist to Kaul Avenue from 64th St. to 73rd St. The original of the legislation is on file in the office of the City Clerk located on the 2nd floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, where said legislation may be examined on any weekday between 8:00 a.m. and 4:45 p.m.
