WEPA Process Overview

- WEPA – Wisconsin Environmental Policy Act (1971)
 - *Identify potential positive and negative impacts*
 - *Solicit public input*
- Follow UW System Guidelines, adopted by UW Board of Regents (Resolution #8015)
- Three types of actions
 - *Type I: Requires development of a full Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)*
 - *Type II: May or may not require an EIS but must be evaluated using an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)*
 - *Type III: does not require an EIA or EIS, but a Preliminary Environmental Review must be on file with UW System*
