4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

While on scene PO Brett Stegerwald and I spoke with the caller who verbally identified himself as Tyler M Bochman (w/m, 9/22/90) who stated that he was physically assaulted by the security at the location of 11400 W Silver spring Dr.

PO Brett Stegerwald spoke with one of the security guards on scene who verbally identified himself as Elijah R Allen (b/m, 9/27/94) who stated that Bochman was told that the club was closing and it was time to leave. Allen stated that Bochman was giving them a hard time due to him being heavily intoxicated and stated that at one point Bochman attempted to run back inside the location. Allen stated that he had then put his arm out to attempt to stop Bochman from running back inside the location. Allen stated that this caused Allen to fall to the ground. Allen stated that he did not intentionally cause any harm to Bochman and was just attempting to stop Bochman from entering back into the closed business.

PO Stegerwald also spoke to two witnesses outside the location. Both witnesses stated that they observed Bochman being removed from the club due to it closing. The two witnesses both stated that Bochman then attempted to run back inside the location, but was stopped by security. 


