 = SIGNAL

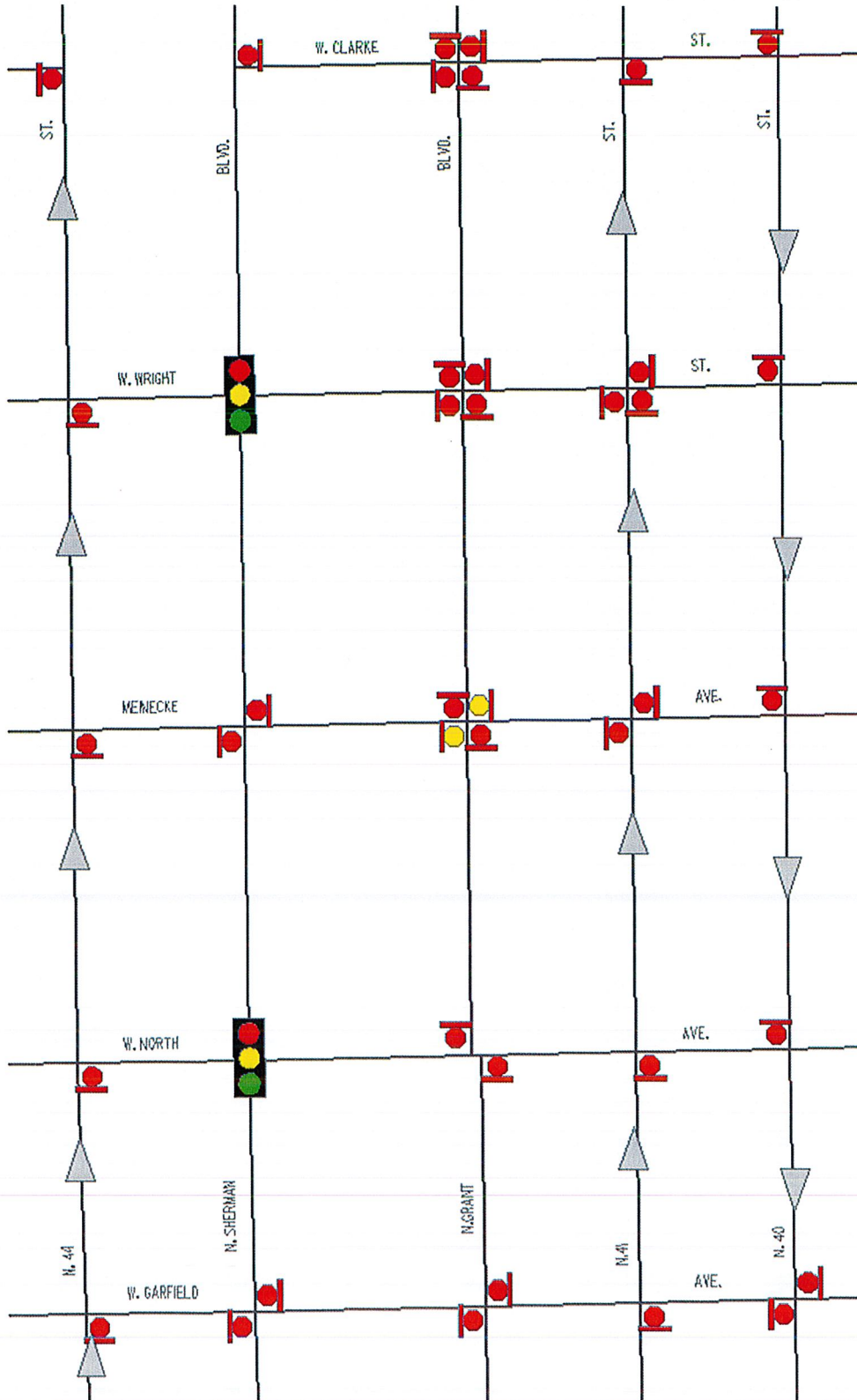
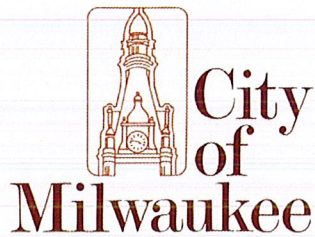

 = NEW YIELD

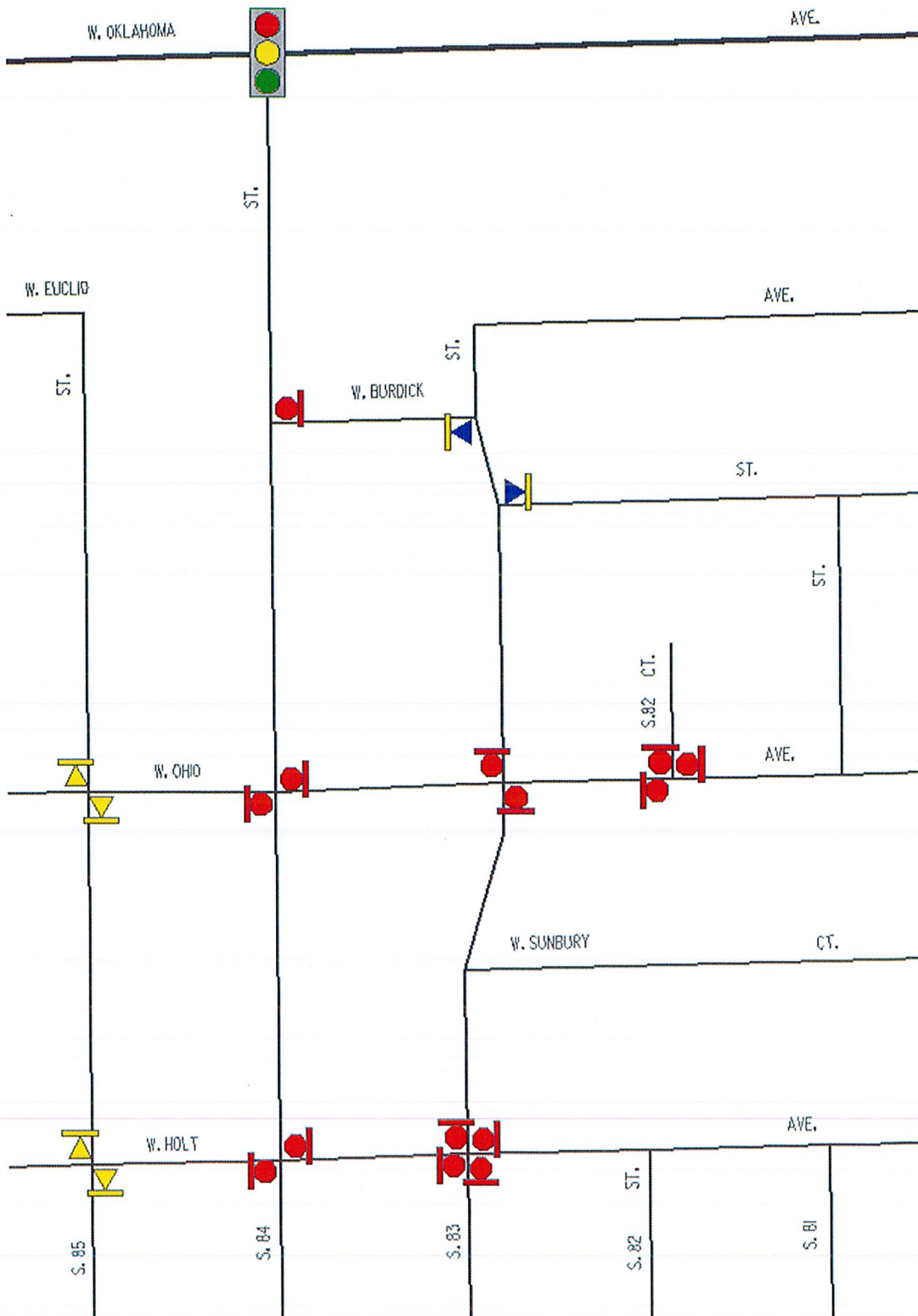
