Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie A. Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers Chris Marshall and Jon Osowski. The claim is in the amount of \$1,353.00 for 12.30 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. A criminal investigation was initiated against the police officers on whose behalf this claim was filed, but they were ultimately not charged.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Wis. Stat. § 895.35, *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

The above-named police officers have retained us to represent them in connection with the above-referenced matter.

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them, and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved a police shooting.

The MPD conducted a criminal investigation and investigated the shooting as a critical incident. IAD compelled POs Marshall and Osowski to give statements after issuing PI-21s. Later, the DA concluded that the officers' conduct was priviliged under the law of defense of others and self defense. Attached is a copy of the DA's letter and and itemization of the time and services rendered.

Dear Chief Jones:

As you know, Milwaukee Police Department Policies and Procedures require a review by this office of police shootings where injury occurs resulting from police action. This letter is written to notify you of our review of an incident involving the shooting of Juan Villegas.

On December 15, 2002, City of Milwaukee Police Officers Jon Osowski and Christopher Marshall fired a number of shots at Juan Villegas, striking and wounding him. Moments prior to the shooting, the officers observed an automobile occupied by Mr. Villegas in a high speed pursuit of a blue Cadillac automobile. The officers followed these automobiles to the location of the incident, the 1500 block of South 36th Street in the City of Milwaukee. Upon arriving at that location, they observed the blue Cadillac crashed against a tree, and the automobile occupied by Mr. Villegas stopped a short distance away. Officers then observed the front seat passenger, later identified as Mr. Villegas, fire a handgun in the direction of the blue Cadillac. At that time, officers ordered the person doing the shooting to stop but the passenger continued to fire in the direction of the blue Cadillac. Fearing for the safety of the occupants of the blue Cadillac, as well as for their own safety, officers fired their service weapons at the front passenger who was firing at the blue Cadillac. At that time, Juan Villegas was wounded by the officers.

This office has concluded an investigation of that shooting and has determined that the actions of the officers were privileged under the law of defense of others and self defense in that the officers reasonably believed that Juan Villegas was going to cause eminent death or great bodily harm to others and/or the officers. Having reached that conclusion, no criminal charges will be brought against either officer for their involvement in this incident.
