1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

Urban Storm Trees and Green BMPs aims to protect and enhance the health of Milwaukee watersheds through implementation of green best management practices. Urban Storm Trees will increase pervious surfaces through the planting of trees and ground cover on city property, measure the impact on stormwater reduction at selected sites using multiple green BMPs such as rain gardens, green parking lots and storm trees and conduct public education and allied professional training on the value of urban greening.

2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

Urban Storm Trees and Green BMPs will assist in maintaining a healthy urban forest. As part of the public awareness component, Milwaukee citizens will be encouraged to plant and maintain trees on private property which improves the environment and appearance of Milwaukee.
