To whom it may concern:

I came into Mil. on the morning of Jan. 12
I exited the 145 freeway & proceeded south on
north 91st St. I was right in front of the
goodwill store when the car in front of me
switched lanes abruptly. I had no chance to
change lanes & was forced to straddle a large
piece of concrete that had obviously broken
off of one corner of one of the large slabs of
concrete of the road. I called street maintenance
& talked to Bill Lewis at 286-2971. I checked back
with him a day or two later & he said that the
work order could be checked for the date of 1-23-82
if you would like to verify this.

I have an older car but it is in good shape
mechanically. After I hit the concrete I only had
low gear & the exhaust was very loud. It was
a very hard impact. I managed to drive it home
in low gear. I had a friend straighten out all
the shifting linkage so I could drive it to ~~see~~ a
muffler shop. The frame also got bent, but
not in a critical spot, I had a stainless exhaust
system ~~on~~ on the car & I am sending you
the estimate to replace the exhaust pipe &
muffler (not the tail pipe) which were ruined.

I don't feel I should have to pay for this as it
was not my fault. I have only liability insurance
so they won't cover it.
