Dear Mr. Whitehead:

This is to notify you that on May 19, 2003 the City's Utilities and Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application as agent for "Met Hall, Inc. Ink" for a Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Dance license for the premises at 3400 North Holton Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Met Hall") be approved with a ten (10) day suspension. The Committee made such a recommendation based upon neighborhood objections.

On May 21, 2003, you were sent a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Utilities and Licenses Committee with respect to your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Dance license in which the Committee recommended that your renewal application be approved with a ten (10) day suspension. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of June 3, 2003 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections or to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did not appear, nor did you file written objections to the report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee.

Following consideration of the report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee, the Common Council made a motion to amend the file to renew your license with no suspension. That amendment was defeated by the Common Council by a vote of eight (8) ayes, eight (8) noes, and zero (0) excused. The council then approved the file as not amended by a vote of sixteen (16) ayes, zero (0) noes, and zero (0) excused.

Said suspension is to be in effect from midnight, June 17, 2003 through midnight, June 28, 2003.
