..Body

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 108-3-7 of the code is repealed and recreated to read:

## 108-3. Definitions.

**7.** PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT PREMISES means a premise or location, whether publicly or privately owned, that is open to access by the public as a matter of right or is made available for use by a member of the public, and that is used for an entertainment, assembly, or recreational purpose. This includes a space rented or reserved for a private or public event such as a performance, cultural gathering, celebration, or community function.
