
- 346.03 (5) the exemptions granted the operator of an authorized emergency vehicle by this section do not relieve such operator from the duty to drive or ride with due regard under the circumstances for the safety of all persons nor do they protect such operator from the consequences of his or her reckless disregard for the safety of others.

According to American Family Insurance, it was a total loss and feel the City of Milwaukee is liable for amount not covered under my policy.

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$6,850.15, relating to damage sustained to your vehicle on January 29, 2003 when it collided with a Milwaukee Police Department vehicle on South Kinnickinnic Avenue and East Ward Street.

Our investigation reveals that the Wisconsin Motor Vehicle Accident Report completed as a result of this accident notes that the Milwaukee Police Department vehicle was operating in an emergency capacity with its warning lights and siren activated. Another vehicle failed to yield the right-of-way and was cited. The liability for this accident is upon the other driver. As such, the City cannot accept liability for the loss. This report is written by police officer Dennis Wallich, dayshift motorcycle unit. On 01-29-2003, at approximately 12:35 PM, Squad 802, Wallich, responded to a squad accident at 2210 S. Kinnickinnic Ave.

Upon arrival, officer Wallich spoke to Sandra K. Nesgoda, driver of Unit #1, who stated she was driving her car southbound on S. Kinnickinnic Ave. and she was slowing down to make a left turn onto E Ward St. when she heard a siren. She looked but didn't see the squad car so she proceeded to make her left turn. All of a sudden, the squad was next to her on the left and she collided with it. Nesgoda stated she was not injured in the accident.

Officer Wallich then spoke to officer Artemio R. Rodriguez, driver of Unit #2, who stated he was driving his squad car southbound on S. Kinnickinnic Ave. responding to a call with his red lights and siren activated. As he approached Unit #1 in front of him, Unit #1 was slowing down so he began to pass Unit #1 on the left. As he was passing, Unit #1 began to turn left.

He tried to go farther left but Unit #1 collided with the right rear of his squad car. This caused him to lose control of the car and he spun around 360 degrees. He thought he was regaining control of the car but then he collided on the left rear with a parked car. He then came to rest up on the sidewalk.

Rodriguez complained of pain to his left side, neck and head. He was conveyed to St. Luke's Hospital by MFD Squad 2 for medical treatment. He was treated by Dr. Reid. Squad 2, SGT. Crouse responded to the scene.

Leandra M. Ganter, owner of Unit #3, was on the scene and stated she heard the crash but did not see it.

On wed 01-29-03 at 12³⁸pm (Sgd 9220 PO Podlisnik & PO E Peerenboom) were responding to a back-up call at 2463 So Graham St. As Sgd 9220 was traveling S/B in the 2200 Blk of So Kinnickinnic Ave we came upon a Sgd accident. Sgd 9220 checked the 3 vehicles involved for possible injuries. There were no injuries to the driver of the maroon Plymouth Voyager EPB, 08/03, VIN # 2P4GH4534MR191012. The other civilian vehicle was a vehicle that was legally parked. The only visible injuries were to the Police officer involved in the accident (Artemio Rodriguez Sgd 24). MFD was called.

I then spoke to the witness who approached me and stated that he saw the accident. The witness name is Miszewski, Eugene R, w/m, 12-30-51, 2862 N Bremen St, Milwaukee, WI 53212, 372-3180.

Miszewski stated he was stopped at intersection of E Ward & So Kinnickinnic Ave facing E/B. Miszewski stated he heard Police sirens then saw the emergency lights of a Police car traveling S/B on Kinnickinnic. In front of the Police car was a maroon van that appeared to be moving towards the right. As the Sgd car passed the van, the van made a sudden left turn onto E. Ward street colliding

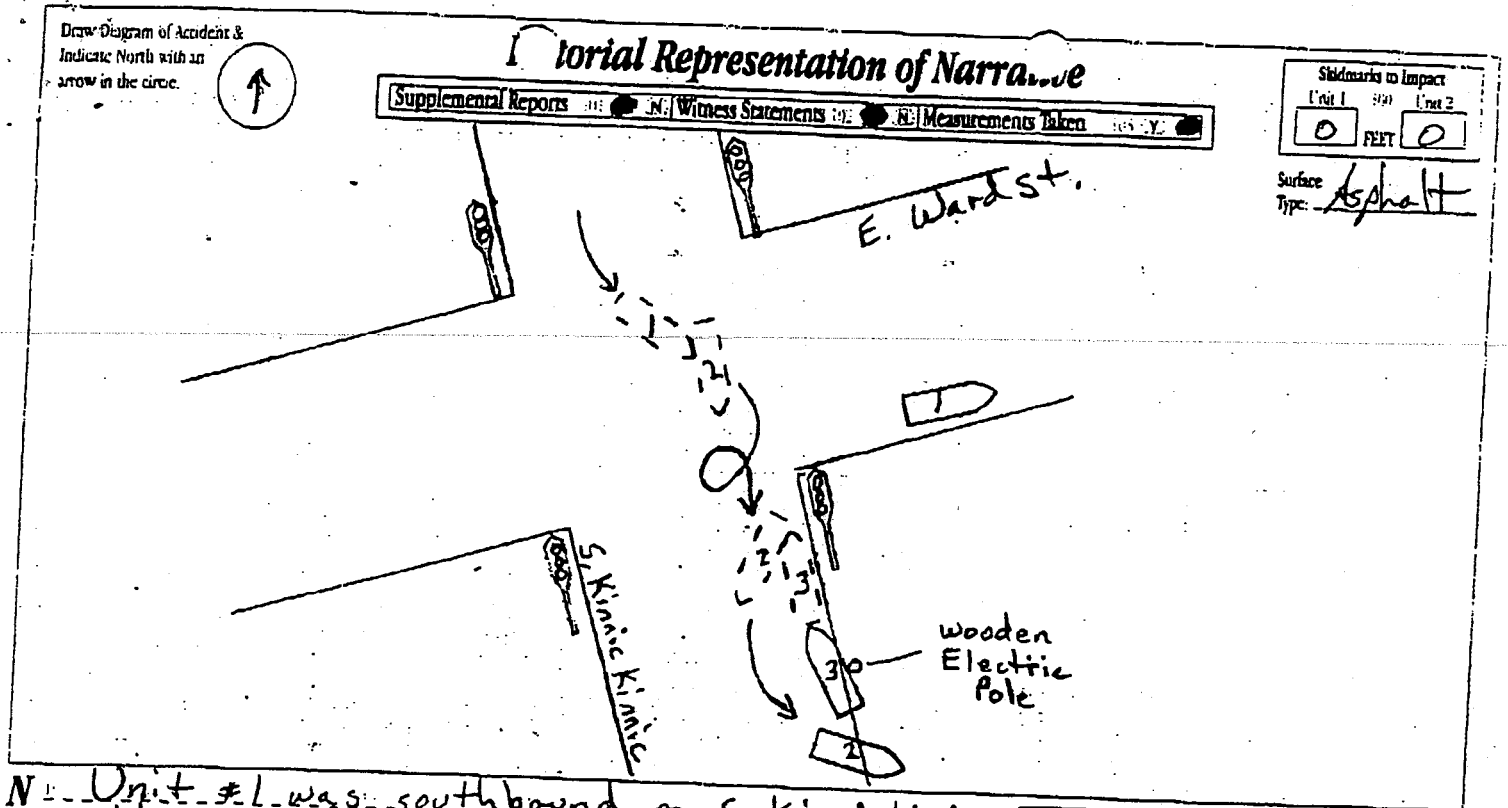

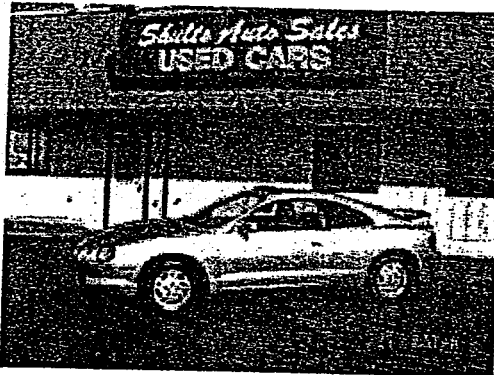
