REASON FOR REQUEST:

Hattie Nichols, a City of Milwaukee employee, was in the scope of her employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was traveling westbound on West Capitol Drive. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West Capitol Drive and North 40<sup>th</sup> Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding northbound on North 40<sup>th</sup> Street, failed to yield the right-of-way, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Ms. Nichols sustained injuries to her head, right arm, knees, ribs, and teeth. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$21,433.26.
