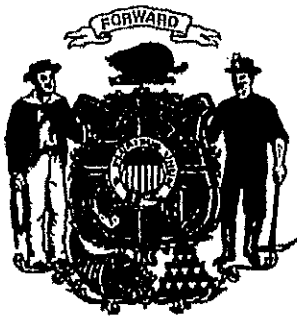

C - Police Contact: Client has had police contact while on supervision No.


D - Overall level of cooperation: has client complied with referrals and services designed to address criminogenic needs Yes.
