I spoke with Zach Schmidt, Legislative Aide to my Alderman, Michael Murphy on Oct. 6th. Mr. Schmidt provided the information on how to file this claim.

For over 20 years the City of Milwaukee has neglected to maintain the alley between 2768 N. 73rd St. and Lefeber Ave. Consequently, the alley has heaved and buckled creating a surface which doesn't allow rain or melted snow to disperse through the channel designed to move it away from our property.

During rain events and snow melts, the water collects in front of and then floods inside our garage, to the extent that one of the walls has water damage and the garage slab has significant cracks. (See the photos and video provided.)

The cost of repairs depends on the extent of damage located underneath the garage slab and the longer this continues the situation will only worsen. Before we even consider repairing or replacing the garage and slab the alley, which is the responsibility of the City of Milwaukee, must be repaired.
