
Dear Mr. Mahan:

MTNA has had the pleasure of serving residents of the Midtown community in partnership with the City of Milwaukee for more than ten years. As a result of this partnership residents have gained valuable skills and become more empowered to advocate for themselves and their neighborhood. 
Dear Mr. Beverly:
