Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. 

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 09/29/2018 a 17-year-old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police and the WI WINS Tobacco initiative was able to purchase a Solo 2 pack e-cigarette from the clerk at Harry Morgan BP, 1930 W. Morgan Av. The clerk admitted the sale stating she looked old enough based on her size. The applicant was mailed a MARTS enrollment package.

2. On 07/26/2020 officers were dispatched to a Shooting at 1930 W. Morgan Av. The officer spoke with a witness who stated he was at the gas station to help his friend drive a car to the shop. He was inside at the counter when he heard gun shots outside. He went outside and found his friend shot. He then followed his friend to the hospital. The business was cooperative and provided the video of the incident.

On Sunday, July 26, 2020 I was dispatched to a shooting that occured at 1930 W MORGAN AVE, in the parking lot of this business.

Upon arrival I spoke to Michael L. ESTRADA (w/m, 10-04-94) who stated that he was friends with the victim and he was inside the gas station when the shooting occurred. ESTRADA stated he was meeting the victim at the gas station because he had just sold his vehicle to the victim and he was going to help the victim drive the vehicle to the car shop. ESTRADA stated that he was walking into the gas station when he heard his friend "Mike" say "look who it is" ESTRADA stated that he slightly turned and saw dark red Chevy Impala put did not see who was in the vehicle. ESTRADA stated that he was at the counter trying to cash some lottery tickets when he heard approximately three gun shots. ESTRADA stated that he ran out the gas station and he drove to st. Lukes Hospital following the victim who was in another vehicle. ESTRADA stated he did not witness the shooting and did not see the suspect.

The employee of the business was very cooperative with police during this investigation and queued up the video footage and time stamped all the important events for us.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 9/29/2020 at 2:20 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.






