There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

**Notice for applicants with
warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings during normal business hours is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of Kilbourn Avenue and Water Street. You must present a copy of the meeting notice to the parking cashier.

Dear Whom it May Concern,

I am writing to strenuously object to the Class B Tavern Liquor License application for the business Back Street at 2116 N. Farwell Ave.

I am

I am writing to ask that you deny back streets class B application For the following reasons:

Applicant has no plan for trash, recycling or refuse removal. Currently, the applicant is using the trash and recycling bins maintained and paid for by Waterford Wine & Spirits and Good City Brewing (also a neighbor of the applicant).

Applicant has dumped trash and construction garbage onto the city street pictures and a complaint with the city), the common parking area, and the city bike path. This has included unset concrete sludge.

Applicant has no plan for noise mitigation or containment. During construction and present operation the tenants in the building consulted with the applicant and landlord about appropriate noise abatement. After each consultation, the applicant immediately ignored the plan set in place by all parties and continued with extreme noise levels at all hours of the day and night.

Applicant has no plan for parking. While the applicant's building has shared common parking, the applicant has routinely parked large vehicles in ways that violate parking regulations and reduce parking, sometimes down to as little as 25% (using one pick-up truck to block four parking spots). When asked politely to move their vehicles, requests were ignored.

Applicant has no plan for security. Applicant has shown no concern (after two break-ins in their building) that they are going to implement a plan for security.

Applicants' staff is ill-trained and hostile. The problems detailed above are not new. All through the applicant's build out, ' the people constructing or operating Back Street and repeatedly been met with silence, swearing, or threats.

Overall, the applicant has shown no sign or willingness to work with its surrounding neighbors on the problems they have created.

In summation, the applicant Back Street is already a bad operator, adding hard alcohol into the mix will amplify these problems. respectfully ask that you deny their Class B application.

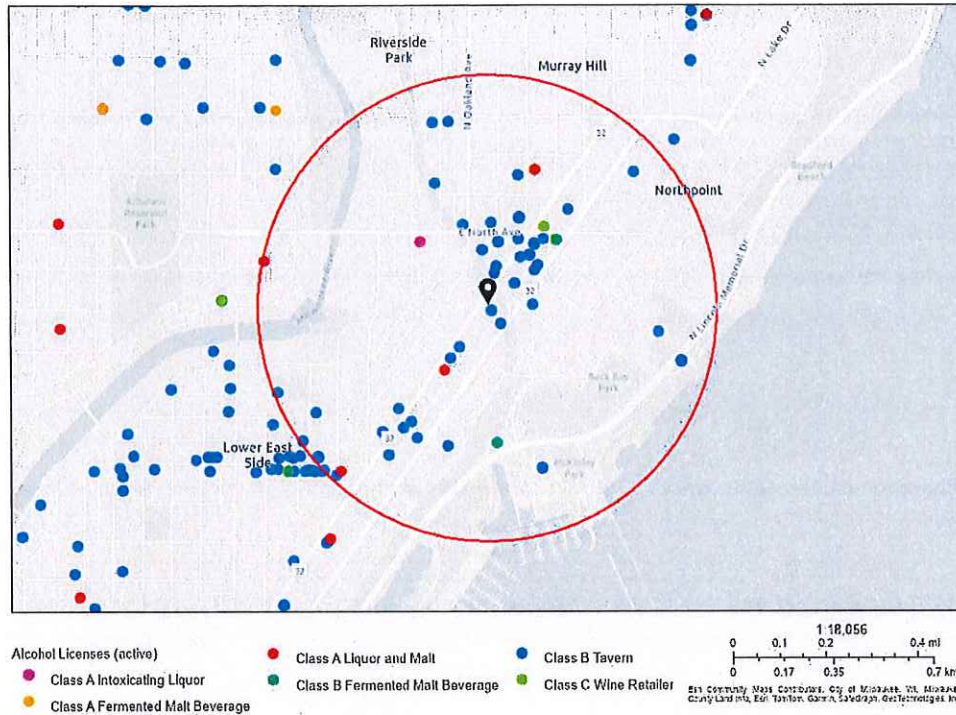


Concentration Map for 2116 N Farwell Av

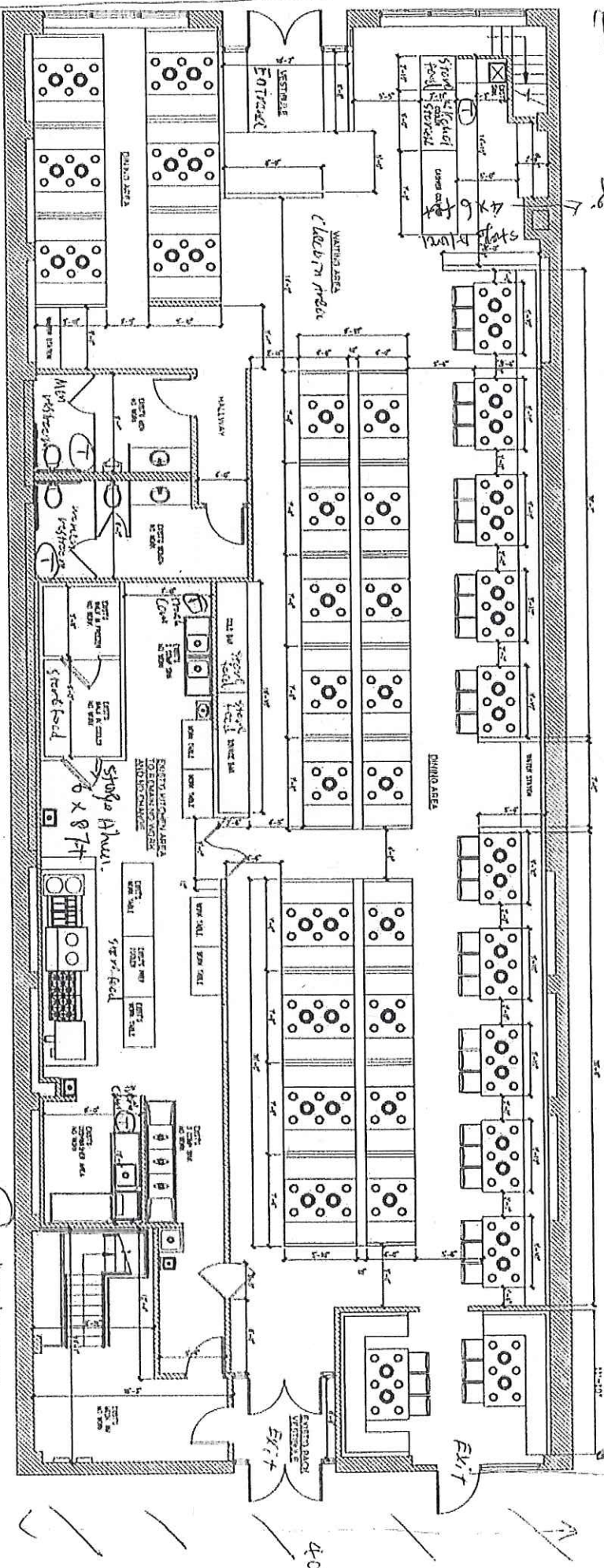
