We are requesting approval of private automobile reimbursement in excess of 1,000 for Nigeria Nealy, Public Health Aide, working in the Tuberculosis Control Program for the Milwaukee Health Department. Ms. Nealy drove her personal vehicle 1,128 for the month of November and 1,076 for the month of December.

Ms. Nealy administers Directly Observed Therapy (DOT) for identified tuberculosis cases in a variety of settings, including client homes and health clinics. The majority of the DOT therapies provided by Ms. Nealy require driving to client homes throughout the City of Milwaukee. The work done by Ms. Nealy is considered one of the most effective strategies to ensure adherence to treatment for tuberculosis.
