**Purpose of Contract:**

The purpose of this contract is to dispense with the City's competitive bidding process to allow the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to enter into a Sole Source Vendor Service Contract for Acadis Training System with Envisage Technologies, LLC (Envisage). In accordance with the vendor quote dated November 6, 2025 and a Master License Agreement, the contract has a value of \$429,569.77 and a contract term from 09/21/2025 through 09/20/2030.

The (MPD) uses Envisage's platform to manage officer certifications and professional development. This agreement allows MPD to continue utilizing the Acadis Readiness Suite (Acadis), which the department relies on to schedule, track, and maintain records of all training activities. Acadis ensures that each officer's training history is accurately documented and accessible. In accordance with MPD's Standard Operating Procedure on Training and Career Development, department members use the MPD Acadis site on the intranet to submit, track, and route training requests for review and approval. The system also enables MPD to meet its reporting obligations to the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Standards Board (LESB), supporting ongoing officer certification requirements.

**Background:**

Under contract E0000017460, MPD has been using Acadis to schedule, track, and archive training for five years. All of this information is then reported to LESB. The State also uses Acadis to track all law enforcement training statewide and is currently working with the software provider to interface with MPD's Acadis system. This integration will significantly improve the accuracy and timeliness of training data reporting between MPD and the State.

**Purpose of Contract:**

The purpose of this contract is to dispense with the City's competitive bidding process to allow the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to enter into a Sole Source Vendor Service Contract for Cellular Monitoring and Investigation Services on Gladiator Platform with Gladiator Forensics, LLC (Gladiator). In accordance with vendor quote MPD-260324 dated 03/24/2026 and vendor software license and service terms, the contract has a value of \$250,405.00 with a term from 06/01/2026 through 05/31/2031 with one (1) year options to renew upon mutual agreement.

Gladiator develops software used by law enforcement agencies for cellular data analysis and investigative support. Its platform is designed to assist with cell phone tracking, data collection, and the organization of information obtained during investigations. The system combines functions that are often handled by multiple tools, allowing agencies to manage cellular forensics and related data within a single platform.

**Background:**

Gladiator uses advanced tools for cellular forensics and intelligence collection that would be utilized by MPD for cell tracking and data analysis. The proposed software would replace both CellHawk (E0000019915) and Penlink PLX (E0000013049), which are the current systems MPD relies on to conduct cell tracking operations. Consolidating these capabilities into a single platform would improve efficiency and streamline investigative workflows. The software offered by Gladiator Forensics is proprietary and uniquely suited to MPD's operational needs.

**Purpose of Contract:**

The purpose of this contract is to dispense with the City's competitive bidding process to allow the Milwaukee Fire Department (MFD) to enter into a Sole Source Vendor Service Contract for Community Paramedic Program Curriculum with University of Wisconsin System Non-Payroll dba University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee (UWM). In accordance with the UWM program curriculum, the contract has a value of \$75,000.00 and contract term of 04/01/2026 – 03/31/2029 with two (2) options to extend for one (1) year period upon mutual agreement.

**Background:**

UWM's College of Nursing has played a key role in advancing paramedic practice through its partnership with the MFD. Rather than offering an entry-level paramedic certification program, UWM developed the only community paramedicine training program for experienced Milwaukee Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) and paramedics in the state of Wisconsin. The partnership between UWM and MFD was formalized through a prior contract (E0000017857) for the same services that was put in place in 2015, reflecting the City's early commitment to expanding the role of paramedics in community-based care. The education model for this program uses a hybrid format that combines classroom instruction with clinical experience to build competency among MFD EMTs and paramedics. Through this blended approach, participants gain training in community and public health, chronic disease management, cultural competency, and care coordination, enabling them to effectively deliver services to patients enrolled in the Milwaukee Fire Department's Mobile Integrated Health (MIH) program.
