Attached is File No. 040718, being a substitute resolution to vacate the north-south alley in the block bounded by South 1st Street, South 2nd Street, West Bruce Street and West Pierce Street, in the 12th Aldermanic District. This vacation was requested by Mike Sanfellipo for expansion of the existing Walkers Point Plaza gas station and convenience store.

The Department of Public Works Coordinated Report contains no stated objections to the proposed vacation. The Commissioner of Public Works has requested a money deposit for the following fees:

1.	Equity in one catch basin	\$ 400.00
