There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing. You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 06/03/07 at 5:49 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 340 E Bay for a Fight and Man With Gun complaints. Officers spoke with the bartender/manager, identified as Jay Poshepny, who stated that two known actors who were outside of the tavern started to argue with some of his patrons who were seated in the beer garden. Poshepny stated he observed these subjects enter the tavern and start to physically fight these patrons who were seated in the beer garden. Poshepny stated he asked these subjects to leave and they refused. Poshepny further stated that one of these subjects displayed a knife and caused damage to the front of tavern. When police arrived, both victims and suspects were gone.
2. On 03/03/2010 at 2:08am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a battery complaint at 338 E Bay Street. Investigation revealed that the bartender working at the time was the victim of a substantial battery by two unknown actors who had been giving her a hard time and becoming argumentative with her prior to refusing to leave the bar at closing. The agent informed officers that his video system was not working due to a burned out motor, but it was being repaired.
3. On 04/15/2010 at 12:10am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a fight at 338 E Bay Street. Investigation revealed that there was an altercation between two patrons that arrived together. The incident started as a verbal argument and escalated into a physical fight with the two punching each other. The bartender called the police while one of the patrons picked up a barstool and struck the other. The bartender told them the police were called and they both fled out the front door. No other patrons were involved.

4. On 03/22/2013, a customer inside the business at 338 East Bay Street (Bay Street Pub) created a disturbance and was cited for Disorderly Conduct. All licenses were current and no violations were observed.

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5. On 03/15/20 at 12:22am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 338 E. Bay Street for a property damage complaint. Upon arrival, officers interviewed the applicant who stated a subject knocked over an air conditioning unit and he was holding him for police. The applicant was advised to see if the unit was, in fact, damaged and to call police with the results.

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6. On 02/14/22 at 10:06pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 338 E. Bay Street for a battery complaint. Surveillance footage revealed that a patron engaged in an argument with the bartender, went behind the bar area, and struck the bartender several times. The patron left the establishment before police arrival. The applicant was cooperative.
 7. On 03/17/22 at 1:21am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 338 E. Bay Street for an overdose complaint. The applicant and employee were cooperative and the applicant showed officers video footage from his phone which captured the overdose inside the tavern.
 8. On 03/18/22 at 8:00pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 338 E. Bay Street. The only violation was the posting of licenses and the staff was cooperative.
 9. On 09/12/22 the applicant was cited in Milwaukee County for Possession of THC.

This report is written by PO Benjamin SPITZER, Assigned to District Two, Late Power, Squad 2484, with PO Oscar ESPITIA.

On Monday, February 14th, 2022 at 10:06 PM we were dispatched to 338 E. Bay St, Bay Street Pub, for a battery complaint against the bartender of the establishment by a customer.

On arrival we spoke with the owner who was cooperative, identified as Mark R. PASCHAL (W/M, 01-06-1962). PASCHAL stated he was informed by his bartender, identified as Theodore D. GONZALES (W/M, 06-30-1954), that he was physically assaulted by a patron. PASCHAL stated one of the subjects named "Tony" called from 414-588-5536 after the incident claiming that the bartender was racist. PASCHAL stated this subject was a regular, but his real name was not known. PASCHAL provided me a copy of the video.

PASCHAL showed me the video which depicted two B/M patrons arguing with GONZALES. Both subjects exited the bar, and return a short time later. The video depicts a B/M with long black hair wearing all black clothing confront GONZALES behind the bar, who strikes GONZALES several times about the face. The video then depicts both subjects exit the establishment and never return.

GONZALES stated that he had pain to the left side of the face, and wished to have a citation issued if the subject was identified.

A check of MPD records for the provided phone number provided negative results.

Upon arrival, officers spoke to the bartender who identified herself as Tereza GRUNTOVA (w/f 4/25/1986) was cooperative and willing to answer all questions. The owner of the bar (Bay Street Pub) who identified himself as Mark R. PASCHAL (w/m 1/6/1962) was also cooperative and willing to answer all questions. PASCHAL did show us some video footage of the incident and was willing to email officers the surveillance video.

It should be noted PASCHAL showed officers from his phone footage that captures the overdose occurring inside the bar.

This report is written by Police Officer (P.O.) Quentin C. ARNOLD, assigned to District Two, Late Power Shift, Squad 2488 partnered with Officer Antwan POWELL. We were both equipped with an AXON body worn camera, which captured this investigation.

On Friday, March 18th, 2022 at approximately 8:00 P.M., (While in full duty Milwaukee Police Uniform operating a marked Milwaukee Police Squad) arrived at Bay Street Pub located at 338 E. Bay Street, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

We then conducted a tavern check of Bay Street Pub. Upon entry we observed four patrons and, only one bartender currently working. We spoke to the sole employee whom I identified by Wisconsin Driver License as STOCKLAND, David Vincent (M/W, 1217 E Norwich apt#6). I spoke to STOCKLAND regarding any issues that are currently ongoing. STOCKLAND said he has no issues with any patrons.

I requested STOCKLAND to provide his bartender license which he complied and is currently up to date. I then requested to see the tavern licenses which I did not observe posted on the walls throughout the tavern. STOCKLAND retrieved the licenses and permits from above a cabinet. I observed all licenses and permits are currently up to date as well but, informed STOCKLAND that those documents must be in an area where they are observable by all and not obstructed. STOCKLAND stated that he will notify the owner immediately and attempt to post them somewhere as soon as possible.

STOCKLAND was cooperative throughout the duration of the tavern check. There were no tavern violations other than posting the licenses and permits in an area observable by all.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 3/07/2023 at 9:10 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
