There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.




Hello Marina, my name it am a resident on the same street as the cactus club. Since the warmer weather has begun and COVID restriction have been being lifted, the cactus club has grown to be a constant reoccurring nuisance to myself and a majority to the neighborhood. The owner refuses to open her business to the public, but still survives drinks out the front door and has tables all over outside for people to congregate at, as if that is a safer method of some kind of social distancing. When they are busy and table are full, the remaining crowd just piles up on the sidewalks. People can't walk over there. Kids can't go outside and ride a bicycle around the block because of the bar patrons taking over the sidewalk. On top of that, the owner has a stage for whatever musical acts or live entertainment she wants to have, but yet she thinks it's okay to host a band a couple weeks ago and some sort of live poetry reading outside on a PA system cranked up. When the band was performing a few weeks ago, i couldn't even get down the street to my drive way because the crowd was so large it spilled out into the street and people refused to move. Milwaukee police department was called. She is always holding a used clothing sale on the sidewalk or has different venders outside selling crafts. Almost nightly

there is some sort of food truck parked out front. Russell is already a narrow enough road. And people drive like idiots trying to race the stop light. Now stick a 9 foot wide by 12 foot tall step van smack dab on the corner and all it is, is a traffic jam, and creates a terrible blind corner, for motorists and pedestrians. This is a quite residential area. The owner is beyond is respectful. She has been approved, multiple times, by lots of the neighborhoods with complaints. They are always brushed off with an "I'm sorry, it won't happen again", to the same thing happening a day later. I really hope to hear back from you in what actions can be taken. She is turning our peaceful block into her businesses free for all.








This isn't the rave. It's a residential area and NOT a music venue.

I have lived on South Wentworth avenue less than a block away from Cactus Club for just over 3 years. The proximity to Cactus Club (along with the other vibrant, local businesses nearby) was a major reason we purchased a house in this part of Bay View. I have heard through the grape-vine that there has been a complaint from one of my neighbors. I'm writing to you to give you my perspective on the value that Cactus Club adds to our neighborhood.

As long as I have lived in Milwaukee (and as I have read for the decades previous), Cactus Club has been a shining light in our art scene. It has provided a space for diverse performers to entertain and inspire us. It's been an essential gathering place for conversations, dancing, football games, film screenings, fundraisers and random celebrations. Since Kelsey took ownership in early 2020 she has made numerous improvements to the building and its relationship to its neighbors. In fact, the previous owner never reached out to us (not that I expected him to!) and the frequency/volume of events is less now than it was before Kelsey took over. If on occasion a popular event draws crowds to our block along with the unavoidable traffic and noise that comes with it, I for one welcome it. Cactus Club is the best of what Bay View has to offer!

I'm sensitive to the fact that my perspective is only one of many on the block but it just didn't feel right to not let you know how I feel in light of the reported complaint. Thanks for your time and keep up the good work!



To whom it may concern:

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 3/08/2022 at 02:25 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
